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On 4/13/21 at approximately 1807 hours Ptl. Canterelli (#312) and I were dispatched to 418 Old Silverton Rd. in reference to an [REDACTED] Dispatch advised a sixty year old male on location was [REDACTED]

Upon arrival we located the resident / victim, James Casey, on the floor in front of the couch in the living room. He had been sitting on the couch, but was placed on the floor by the caller, at the instruction of the [REDACTED] He was [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] At this time Ptl. Canterelli (#312) and I began [REDACTED] The [REDACTED] were placed on Casey. [REDACTED] After a brief period, Hackensack-Meridian medics Manfre, Schwester, Monaghan, and Vogt arrived as well as members of BTPD Med unit 531. Ptl. DeLuca (#276) and Ptl. Robbins (#311) also arrived to assist.

While the medics and EMS personnel were attempting [REDACTED] Casey, I spoke with witnesses [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] informed me he owns the residence and has rented a room to Casey for over twenty years. He provided me with the following account of events:

Casey has not been feeling well for several days. Casey [REDACTED] Today, he was in the back yard with neighbors / friends [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] At approximately 1705 hours he called Casey, who was out of the house. Casey informed him he was pulling in the driveway as they spoke. He advised Casey they were in the yard and asked that he join them. Casey never did. About thirty minutes later [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went home, and he went into the house. As he walked past the living room he observed Casey sitting on the couch watching television. His head was down and he appeared to be sleeping, which was common. He left Casey and went to his room. Approximately thirty minutes later he returned to Casey and began talking to him, hoping to wake him. [REDACTED] He then shook Casey and realized [REDACTED] He called [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] to come over, and called 9-1-1.

[REDACTED] informed me Casey is a heavy alcohol drinker, and marijuana smoker. [REDACTED] stated Casey [REDACTED] was unaware of Casey's medical history and no medications were found.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] confirmed [REDACTED] account of events.

Despite the best efforts the medical personnel, Casey was [REDACTED] He was [REDACTED] I contacted the Ocean County Sheriff Department radio room and spoke with Medical Examiner Dr. Joyce. After hearing the facts in the matter, Dr. Joyce stated he would not be responding to the residence, but would be performing [REDACTED] The Ocean County Sheriff's Department dispatched the Colonial Funeral Home to transport Casey to the Community Medical Center.

While waiting for the funeral home to respond Det. Bennett (#279) and Det. Farnkopf (#230) responded to investigate the scene. There was no sign of trauma to Casey and nothing suspicious around the circumstances.

Rob Proft and Anthony Dambrosio from Colonial Funeral Home responded and transported Casey.

A small quantity of marijuana was located on an end table near Casey. It was collected and placed into property to be destroyed.

Casey's sister, Catherine Casey-Gratto, was notified personally by the Elmwood Park Police Department at our direction.

Casey was wearing tan long pants with a belt, white socks, and a green long sleeve shirt.

On 04/13/2021 at approximately 1807 hours, Ptl. Miller #218, Ptl. Robbins #311, Ptl. Canterelli #312, and I responded to 418 Old Silverton Road in reference to a [REDACTED] male subject, James Casey. Upon arrival to the scene, [REDACTED] were performed by police personnel on scene, as well as Brick Township Police EMS, and JFK Medics, but were unsuccessful (See Ptl. Miller's case report for further).

Mr. Casey was ultimately [REDACTED] hours and as a result, a crime scene log was created.

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On 06/22/21 at 2250 hours, Sgt. Feeney #200, Ptl. Haugh #217, and I, Ptl. Quinn #300 responded to 13 Hollycrest Drive in reference to a burglary.

Upon arrival, we spoke with one of the victims identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she had been staying with her friend [REDACTED] who is the homeowner of 13 Hollycrest Dr. [REDACTED] further explained [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] and was recently transported [REDACTED] where he remained. [REDACTED] stated on the day of 06/21/21 she had been over her friend, [REDACTED] residence located at 4 Hollycrest Dr, while [REDACTED] remained [REDACTED]. After [REDACTED] was at [REDACTED] residence for a few hours, she returned to [REDACTED] residence to check on him. When [REDACTED] arrived at [REDACTED] residence, his condition [REDACTED] and he was in [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] returned to [REDACTED] residence and advised [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] current condition. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] called for medical assistance and they returned to John's residence until EMS arrived. [REDACTED] explained she and [REDACTED] were accompanied by [REDACTED] daughter [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] boyfriend Jason Feliciano. [REDACTED] had stated while they were at [REDACTED] residence with Police and EMS, Walton Britton and his girlfriend arrived at the residence. [REDACTED] stated Walton and his girlfriend were inside the residence for approximately twenty minutes and then left. [REDACTED] further stated once [REDACTED] to the [REDACTED] she, [REDACTED], and Jason left the residence and the rear door was supposed to be secured.

[REDACTED] then returned to [REDACTED] residence where she remained for a few hours before she returned to [REDACTED] residence at approximately 2400 hours. [REDACTED] had stated while she was at [REDACTED] residence, Walton and his girlfriend left the residence and did not return the rest of the night. Once [REDACTED] was inside [REDACTED] residence, she got ready for bed and slept on the couch in the living room. I asked [REDACTED] if the rear door was locked when she arrived, [REDACTED] stated yes. [REDACTED] further stated nothing appeared to be suspicious or out of the ordinary. [REDACTED] advised me she saw her gold wedding and engagement ring with multiple diamonds on the living room television stand, as well as the blue and gold fish necklace and the see-through bag which contained multiple rings. I asked [REDACTED] if she had secured the rear door after she had entered the residence, she stated yes.

[REDACTED] advised me when she woke up at approximately 0600 hours, it appeared someone had been inside the residence. [REDACTED] explained things inside the residence were moved and it looked as if someone had gone through her belongings. [REDACTED] stated that was when she noticed her jewelry was gone as well as other unknown items. I asked [REDACTED] if she was missing any U.S. Currency, specifically coins, she stated yes and explained a coffee container, containing loose change had been taken. [REDACTED] further stated the coffee container taken was black and yellow, and labeled "Chock Full O' Nuts, which also had a yellow lid. [REDACTED] then showed me [REDACTED] loose change container which she claimed had been half full and was now empty. It should be noted there were no signs of forced entry to the rear door or the front door of the residence.

After speaking to [REDACTED], I contacted [REDACTED] to attempt to speak to [REDACTED]. I was advised by [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. At this time, Det. Talty #250 arrived on scene to assist with the investigation.

After I spoke to [REDACTED] nurse, I returned to the residence to continue to speak to [REDACTED]. While I spoke to [REDACTED], Det. Talty returned to his vehicle and observed a silver Honda Accord bearing New Jersey registration [REDACTED] headed in the direction of 7 Hollycrest Drive. Det. Talty observed that the vehicle was operated by Jason Feliciano. Det. Talty knew from previous encounters that Feliciano's driver's license was suspended. At this time, Det. Talty conducted a motor vehicle stop and Jason complied. After I spoke to [REDACTED] I walked to Det. Talty's motor vehicle stop where he advised me of Jason's past police history as well as what he had learned from speaking to Jason (see Det. Talty's case supp. for further details). Based on the statements made by Jason who was read Miranda, we asked Jason consent to search his motor vehicle as well as his person. Jason agreed and a Consent to Search Form was completed and explained in detail multiple times. Jason willingly provided consent and signed the form. A search of Jason's car yielded negative results for any of the items reported stolen. A search of his person also yielded negative results.

After we spoke to Jason, we responded to 4 Hollycrest Dr., where Det. Talty spoke with Walton Britton (see Det. Talty's Case Supp. for further details). Once Det. Talty was finished, he then spoke to [REDACTED] (see Det. Talty's Case Supp. for further details). After Det. Talty spoke to [REDACTED] we advised both she and Walton were free to leave.

Before we left the area, the street was canvassed for residential cameras. We discovered 3,6,11, and 12 Hollycrest Drive all have cameras.

OfficerID: rtalty, Narrative

On 06/22/2021 at 2310 hours, I responded to 13 Hollycrest Drive in reference to a burglary investigation. Also on scene was Sgt. Feeney #200, Ptl. Haugh #217, and Ptl. Quinn #300.

On location Ptl. Quinn was speaking with the victim, [REDACTED] gathering information for a report. [REDACTED] initially described various items taken from her residence including various jewelry and a gold wedding ring. On 06/22/2021 at 1448 hours, Brick Police and EMS responded to this location for a [REDACTED]. The caller, Jason Feliciano, was on location during the first aid call (See case report by Ptl. Quinn).

On 06/21/2021 at 1814 hours, Det. Person and I conducted a motor vehicle stop on a silver Honda Accord [REDACTED] in Drum Point Plaza. Feliciano was operating the vehicle and his driving privileges were suspended. Also present during the motor vehicle stop in the vehicle was Walton Britton. During the motor vehicle stop, Britton and Feliciano stated they were driving to Stop and Shop to cash change. I observed a yellow Chock Full O'Nuts coffee container on the back seat. Both subjects indicated this container held the change which they were going to cash. Britton further stated prior to the motor vehicle stop, they were going to sell a gold ring at Michelle's Jewelry but they were closed. While Britton stated he was going to "sell the ring", he pointed toward his right hand where I observed a gold diamond ring. This encounter was captured on Body Worn Camera (C#42052-21)

On 06/22/2021 while on location of the burglary, I observed a silver Honda Accord [REDACTED] slowly drive on Hollycrest toward Mandalay Road. I observed the driver and identified him from previous police related encounters as Jason Feliciano. Knowing Feliciano's driving privileges were suspended, I instructed him to pull behind my vehicle where I conducted a motor vehicle stop.

Feliciano resides at 4 Hollycrest Drive along with his girlfriend [REDACTED] and her brother Walton (Augie) Britton. Feliciano advised he was driving home from Wawa where he purchased lottery tickets. I asked Feliciano if he was aware of any burglaries in the area, he shook his head stating "no". Feliciano then explained he was at 13 Hollycrest Drive during the [REDACTED]. After the first aid call, Feliciano stated he left and went home. Feliciano asked me "Did [REDACTED] call the cops", I questioned Feliciano why would [REDACTED] call the police he stated "someone called, burglary". I then asked Feliciano to exit the motor vehicle, he was directed toward the trunk area. While exiting the vehicle Feliciano stated "It wasn't me". Believing Feliciano may have knowledge on the burglary, I read him Miranda warnings. Feliciano indicated he understood his rights and was willing to speak to me. Feliciano was asked if he was under arrest, I replied "You're not under arrest". Feliciano immediately began stating he knew of the burglary and that change was "robbed". I asked Feliciano about the change I previously observed during the 06/21/2021 motor vehicle stop. Feliciano explained he didn't know the change was stolen but stated Augie (Walton Britton) was in the house after he left the first aid call. Feliciano stated "I heard tonight her house was robbed". Feliciano continued to express he wasn't involved but Augie was the individual who robbed the house. Feliciano admitted to driving with Augie to Stop and Shop to cash approximately \$80.00 in change. Feliciano explained and described a ring he saw Augie wearing on 06/21/21; Feliciano described the ring as a gold 14k ladies wedding band. Feliciano indicated Augie was trying to pawn the ring along with other costume jewelry. Ptl. Quinn and I conducted a consent search of the motor vehicle (See Ptl. Quinn's report).

After speaking with Feliciano, Sgt. Feeney, Ptl. Quinn, and I responded to 4 Hollycrest to speak with Walton. Upon arrival, Walton appeared from the backyard and was directed toward the driveway. I informed Walton I had questions regarding an incident occurring on Hollycrest Drive. I read Walton Miranda warnings which he understood and further agreed to speak with me. Walton stated he had knowledge of the first aid call at the house but had no idea what happened. Walton later stated he was at the house for the first aid call prior to the motor vehicle stop. Walton expressed he had no knowledge of any missing items from 13 Hollycrest Drive. Walton did state him and Feliciano were going to cash the change located in the vehicle. I asked Walton where he was driving to prior to Stop and Shop, he stated "The jewelry store". Walton stated Feliciano has a necklace he was trying to sell, "whatever he had". This contradicts the statement Britton made to me on the 06/21/2021 motor vehicle stop. Walton continued to change his story and express he has no knowledge of any burglary or theft. He insisted he never went back to 13 Hollycrest after the first aid call.

After speaking with Walton, I observed [REDACTED] standing in the driveway. [REDACTED] previously stated she wished to speak with me. While speaking to [REDACTED] he explained the [REDACTED] on 06/21/2021 and that she and Jason were at the house to help the homeowner. I explained to [REDACTED] officers were investigating a burglary which occurred at 13 Hollycrest Drive. [REDACTED] stated she has no direct knowledge but "heard some stuff was stolen". [REDACTED] suspected Walton being the burglary suspect. [REDACTED] stated Walton commonly sells jewelry at a pawn shop located in Toms River at the intersection of Route 37 and Hooper Avenue. [REDACTED] explained this location does not check ID and melts the jewelry down quickly. She believes he went to this location today early in the morning with his girlfriend [REDACTED].

Feliciano was issued a motor vehicle summons for driving while suspended.
