On 12/25/2022 at approximately 1702 hours, Sgt. Bennett #279, Ptl. Maehl #310, and I, responded to 2235 Hooper Ave in reference disorderly subject. The caller, Megan Damico, advised that her fiancée's father, Randall Long, was out of control inside the residence. She also stated that she did not feel safe inside the residence and believes Randall needs psychiatric help.

Upon arrival, I spoke with Damico outside of the residence. In speaking with her, Damico appeared to have some kind of mental disability which she later stated. She stated that she is disabled and that her fiancée, Christopher Long, is her caregiver. She stated that Randall is her part time caregiver when Christopher is not around. Damico said that Randall had yelled at her and she did not feel safe in that kind of environment with her disability. She also stated that she believes Randall should be evaluated because she thinks that he is depressed. Damico made no mention of there being any kind of physical altercation.

I then spoke with Randall and Christopher inside of the residence. Randall stated that he does not want to harm himself or anyone else. He stated that he feels fine and had an argument with Damico earlier in the day. After this, he went for a drive to cool down before returning to the residence. Randall stated that he did not want to go to the hospital and believes that Damico called the police because she was mad at Randall for yelling at her. Christopher verified Randall's account of the events and stated that he is most likely going to break up with Damico in the near future. He stated that he was willing to give Damico a ride to a friend's house for the night to avoid any further issues. Both Randall and Christopher appeared perfectly normal which was inconsistent with Damico's statements to dispatch.

I then spoke with Damico again and she stated that she wanted to go to the hospital for a burn on her hand. She stated that she previously burned her hand cooking and I observed an extremely minor red mark on her hand. EMS then spoke with Damico and advised that the hospital would not be able to treat the red mark. Damico insisted on being transported to the hospital and was transported in the ambulance. At the hospital, EMS spoke with the hospital staff who then advised they would be doing a PESS evaluation.

My department issued body-worn camera was activated during this incident.
