On 11/1/24 at 2111 hours, Berkeley Radio room received a call reporting a male suffering a diabetic episode. Sgt Butler was dispatched to the scene.

Upon his arrival, the male was alert and conscious but acting erratically. The male had to be restrained on the EMS stretcher for his own safety. RWJ Medics then checked the male's blood sugar and it was learned he was not having a diabetic emergency. It was then ascertained that the male frequently uses heroin and it was believed he was suffering an overdose. The male was identified as [REDACTED] was then transported to CMC.

I (Ptl Leighton) then arrived on scene. Upon my arrival, I spoke to the caller who directed myself to where [REDACTED] as located in the living room. In the immediate vicinity I observed there to be an open cigarette container. Upon further examination, I observed approximately 15 waxfolds of suspect heroin which was seized. The stamp on the waxfold was "Infiniti." Sgt Butler then completed OD Maps.
