The City of Wildwood received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on February 25, 2021. The official Records Custodian, Christopher h. Wood, City Clerk, received your OPRA request on February 25, 2021. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 8, 2021, this response to your request is being provided to you on the 4th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

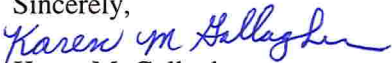
"1. All projects submitted to the Planning & Zoning Board in the last 12 months and also pending projects scheduled to go in front of the board. 2. Copy of all meetings for the past 12 months. 3. All email or text messages between Planning & Zoning Board Members and City of Wildwood Employees. 4. All artist renditions of any projects approved or pending by the Planning & Zoning Board".

Your request for all information, requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5. i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time until March 22, 2021.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the City of Wildwood to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
