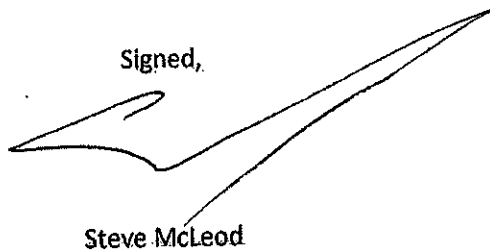

AMENDMENT OF COMPLAINT:

Pursuant to Rule 15 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs Steve McLeod respectively move the court for leave to file attached Amended Complaint for Permanent injunction and other Equitable Relief ("Amended Complaint).

Rule 15 provides that 'a party amend its pleading {with} the court's leave" and that the court should freely give leave when justice so requires." Fed. R. Civ.P. 15.

The Plaintiff also believe that such rights shall be granted base on the fact that defendants as not been serve at this point. Plaintiff also requesting that the part of his case that was transfer to Pennsylvania Western District to be relocated to this court, the court of origin to keep all matters under the same jurisdiction. Plaintiff had every right to file such mater in the United States District Court District of New Jersey base on the following Jurisdiction "Diversity":

- I. Plaintiff permanently resides in New Jersey.
- II. Some Defendants does business in New Jersey
- III. Defendants, Brick New Jersey Police department and New Jersey Children Youth and Family Services are located in New Jersey.
- IV. Dickie McCamey and Chilcote attorneys at law does business in New Jersey.

Through the Amendment Complaint, Plaintiffs seek to add fourteen defendants. Tara Hopper Rice Esq., 2) Jeffrey Robert Hantz Esq., 3) Judge Kim

Berkley Clark, 4) Brick New Jersey Police Department, 5) New Jersey Children Youth and Family Services of Ocean County New Jersey, 6) Daniel Regan, 6) Sabrina Korbel Esq, 7) Margret Prescott Esq, 8) Donald Macejka, 9) Allegheny County Sheriff Department, 10) Barbara Clements Esq, 11) Donald Jerich Esq, 12) Dickie, McCamey and Chilcote attorneys at Law, 13) Allegheny County Sheriff Department, 14) Women Center and Shelter of Greater Pittsburgh. These defendants are, and some have continue to be involved in the scheme to victimized plaintiff and his daughter by retaliation, separation of father and daughter, bias, unnecessary delays of court proceedings, Xenophobic, racism, excessive fines, perjury, concealment of evidence, and money laundering. Plaintiff believe that, along with the original Defendant, these new Defendants engaged in practices that violate Plaintiff 6th Amendment, 8 Amendment, 11 Amendment, and 14 Amendment. The Defendants also violated Plaintiff Civil Rights under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 ET AL. These new counts are base ongoing action by defendants who refuse to recuse from Plaintiffs custody case FD-06-004537 in the Common Pleas court of Allegheny, Pennsylvania, Civil Division, actively conspiring, and bonding together to inflict medical and psychological damages to Plaintiff and his daughter, Defendants using Plaintiff's child as a pawn to punish plaintiff. Plaintiff is separated from his daughter from January third, 2019 to present by using the premise of a false allegation, color of law and their power to control plaintiff visitation. Judge Daniel Regan and Judge Hugh F McGough are

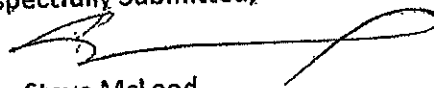

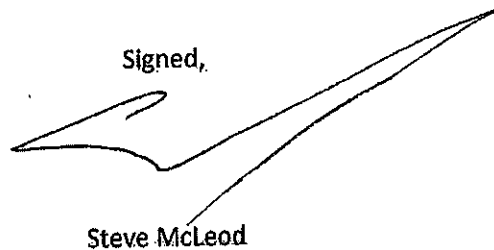
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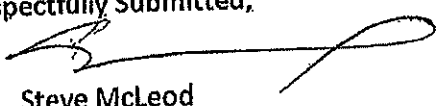
