Dear Ms. Kennedy:

I am in receipt of your recent OPRA request, whereby you requested the following:

1. Total amount of funding received from CTCL (aka Center for Tech and Civic Life)
-- both in this immediately past election cycle, and
-- in any previous election cycles going back to Jan 1 2020
2. Any grants awarded from or submitted to Center for Tech and Civic Life (aka CTCL)
3. The dollar amount of such grants in #2 above.
4. How was the money in #3 above spent? Provide specific categories and spending amounts in every election cycle which used funding from CTCL.
5. Minutes of the Board of Elections meetings during which Center for Tech and Civic Life (CTCL) and its funding was discussed and/or approved
6. Provide a copy of any CTCL grant applications
7. Provide a digital copy (PDF or image) of emails where "CTCL" or "Center for Tech and Civic Life" is mentioned since 1 Jan 2020.

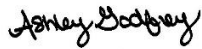
Please be advised that we are still in the process of locating, identifying and reviewing records potentially responsive to your request. Thereafter, any such responsive records will need be re-viewed and, if necessary, redacted, should any OPRA exemption and/or privilege be found to apply. As such, additional time is required to thoroughly and properly respond to your request. See, *Werner v. NJ Civil Service Commission*, GRC Complaint No. 2011-151 (December 2012) (Custodian requested an extension of time in writing within the statutorily mandated seven (7) business days and provided an anticipated date by which the records would be made available, the Custodian properly obtained said extension pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g). and 5(i)); *Criscione v. Town of Guttenberg (Hudson)*, GRC Complaint No. 2010-68 (November 2010) (The GRC determined that because the Custodian provided a written request for an extension on the sixth (6th) business day following receipt of the OPRA request and provided a date certain on which to expect production of the records requested, the Custodian properly obtained said ex-tension, notwithstanding that Complainant did not

agree to the extension of time. The GRC further determined that the extension was reasonable in part, based upon the volume of records re-requested).

Rest assured, we are processing your request as quickly as possible and will respond to you further no later than **July 23, 2021**. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me. In addition, you should know that if you believe that our response does not comply with existing law, you have the right to bring an action in the Superior Court of New Jersey, or to appeal to the Government Records Council.
