I am in receipt of your recent OPRA request, whereby you requested the following:

From July 2021-July 22, 2022, All communications (including emails, newsletters, alerts, electronic postings, text messages) Burlington County sent/provided/posted to its Health Department employees that contain info/updates about and implementation of p.l. 2021, C. 182 Lead-Based Paint Inspection in Rental Dwellings, Guidelines, Regulations, NJAC 5:28A. Records of all required training/competency completions/continuing educations Names, Dates of Burlington County employee attendance/completions for the same law, guidelines, regulations and code about Lead Paint Inspection in rental dwellings.

Please be advised that we are still in the process of locating, identifying and reviewing records potentially responsive to your request. Thereafter, any such responsive records will need to be reviewed and, if necessary, redacted, should any OPRA exemption and/or privilege be found to apply. As such, additional time is required to thoroughly and properly respond to your request. See, Werner v. NJ Civil Service Commission, GRC Complaint No. 2011-151 (December 2012) and Criscione v. Town of Guttenberg (Hudson), GRC Complaint No. 2010-68 (November 2010).

Rest assured, we are processing your request as quickly as possible and will respond to you further no later than **September 21, 2023**. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me. In addition, you should know that if you believe that our response does not comply with existing law, you have the right to bring an action in the Superior Court of New Jersey, or to appeal to the Government Records Council.
