Marc valued the cameras at \$6.00 but an online search shows that they are valued at approximately \$20.00. Marc advised that the most recent theft occurred sometime this morning (unknown what time). I advised Marc that the incident would be documented and provided him with a case number. Note that the BWC footage was captured/saved under incident #23024339 as I was speaking with Marc about an unrelated incident. Nothing further at this time.

On 12/09/2023 at 13:07 hours, Ptl. Sanders and I (Ptl. Dufrat) were dispatched to 39 Overhill Dr. for the report of suspicious activity. Upon arrival, I spoke with the reporting party, Marc Jellinek (37 Overhill Dr.) who advised that moments prior, he witnessed a dark skinned male taking pictures of 39 Overhill Dr. including the porch area. Marc was concerned because the male was taking pictures of the porch and there is a high amount of package thefts in the area. Marc explained that when he approached the male, the male left in a red jeep with a hard top. Marc added that he did not have his glasses on, so he did not get a good look at the suspect. I attempted to call the resident of 39 Overhill Dr. but was unsuccessful, dispatch advised that they would attempt to make a notification of the suspicious activity. A search of the area yielded negative results for the involved vehicle. Nothing further at this time.
