The Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) requests on August 5, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your requests is August 15, 2024. This response is being provided to you on the seventh (7th) business day after receipt.

Pursuant to your request, you have requested: I am requesting the investigation report/findings for the internal affairs complaint R-24-006 filed in regards to the Gloucester County Sheriff Office.

I am requesting this record under common law.

Please be advised that after a search of our records, Gloucester County Prosecutor's office has not found any documents responsive to your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfulfilled within these seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Gloucester County Prosecutor's Office to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing a Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by email at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at its website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
