I have reviewed all Internal Affairs cases and training efforts for the Montclair State University Police Department. The Department received two internal affairs complaints in Essex County during 2017. The first report alleged differential treatment by three police officers. Officers provided statements and the case was thoroughly investigated. This was not sustained as the complainant refused to cooperate and notified Internal Affairs that he would not pursue the matter.

The second complaint occurred in the 4th quarter of 2017 and was made by the same citizen after he was arrested for drug possession and being under the influence. In this case he alleged excessive force, improper arrest, improper search and sexual assault during the search. The case was reviewed by your office and remanded to our agency for investigation. After a thorough investigation, the allegations were not sustained.

During the second half of 2017, all agency members attended de-escalation training as well as Attorney General and Domestic Violence updates. I am continuing our program of training that involves positive communications for police interactions. Our agency goal continues to be finding innovative methods of communication to minimize demeanor complaints. IA officers will continue to strengthen relationships with your Professional Standards Bureau to facilitate an environment of understanding and collective investigation.

There are four officers assigned to Internal Affairs including one Commander reporting directly to the Chief of Police.

The Department received a total of 1 Internal Affairs complaint in Essex County during the 4th quarter of 2018. This was a demeanor complainant where a citizen was unhappy with an officer's decision to issue a motor vehicle summons. The officer was exonerated.

During the 4th quarter of 2018, all agency members attended training on Attorney General Guidelines and Domestic Violence updates. We concluded CLEAR training for Cultural Diversity. I am continuing our program of training that involves positive communications for police interactions. Our agency goal continues to be finding innovative methods of communication to minimize demeanor complaints. IA officers will continue to strengthen relationships with your Professional Standards Bureau to facilitate an environment of understanding and collective investigation. Additionally, we purchased Body Worn Cameras for all officers. We are currently in the training phase with an anticipated deployment date of January 15, 2019.

We have not identified any of our officers needing enhanced supervision.
