On 11/09/2020, I responded to 1435 North Maple Drive (Oxford Halfway House) in regards to a male subject with no pulse and cold to the touch. Upon arrival, Vineland EMS was on scene working on the victim and I spoke with the caller, [REDACTED] who stated the following. The victim, Jason A. Hill is one of his roommates. His other roommate, [REDACTED] contacted him about Jason. He was asked to check on Jason because he did not show up to work. [REDACTED] opened Jason's bedroom door and found him deceased on the floor.

[REDACTED] was asked when he last saw Jason and if he had any company over in the past couple days. He stated he last saw Jason alive on 11/07/2020 around 1PM. He stated Jason stayed to himself and was always in his room if he was not working. [REDACTED] stated he remembered Jason receiving a haircut in the last couple days but does not remember who came over. He stated Jason has been living there for two weeks so he does not know much about him. He explained Jason was attending drug court and had a parole officer by the name of Iris Gonzalez.

I walked into Jason's room, observed Jason was on his knees with his face to the floor. From what I could see there were no signs of trauma or injuries to the body. He was dressed in what appeared to be pajamas and the television was on. He had no pulse, cold to the touch and was blue to the face. There were no signs of foul play and the room appeared orderly. Vineland EMS found Jason's wallet in his room to look for his ID but his ID was not in there. I checked his phone which was on the night stand charging and I observed his license in the phone case. Jason is known to use narcotics due to the past overdoses reported in this department. The two most recent overdoses were on 11/07/2020 (2020-63683) and 08/30/2020 (2020-50102). Vineland EMS, who was still on scene, contacted Doctor Fiorosisky who pronounced Jason deceased at 07:25 AM on 11/09/2020.

I made contact with [REDACTED] via cellphone to speak with him regarding Jason. While speaking with

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█████, he stated he last saw Jason on 11/6/2020. █████ stated they work and live together but they rarely see each other because Jason keeps to himself and goes to work with his supervisor earlier than █████ does. █████ was asked if Jason had any visitors in the past couple days and he said no. █████ stated Jason's supervisor asked him about Jason because he did not show up to work. █████ stated he called █████ who checked on Jason and observed he was deceased.

I spoke with another roommate, █████ who stated he last saw Jason at 11/07/2020 late in the afternoon. █████ stated Jason keeps to himself and when he is home he only sees him go to his room and to the bathroom. █████ stated he did not hear anything from Jason's room to indicate any type of struggle or foul play. █████ stated he would know if there was a struggle because his room is side by side with Jason's room. █████ did not know that Jason was deceased.

I spoke with another roommate, █████ who stated he works and lives with Jason. He stated Jason keeps to himself and he last saw Jason on 11/06/2020 at work. █████ stated he knows nothing about Jason because he has only been in the residence for a short time and they do not talk at work.

The Southern Regional Medical Examiners Office was contacted, at which time I advised Medical Examiner Aimee Rohrbach of the incident. She stated she would respond shortly. When she arrived she conducted her investigation. During the investigation Jason was rolled over and checked at which time I was able to observe there were no apparent injuries to the body. The medical Examiner's transport team then responded to the scene and took Jason to continue the investigation (ME case #06-20-0540).

The Cumberland County Prosecutors Office was contacted, Detective Sergeant W. Phifer stated no one would be responding at this time.

Sergeant R. Watkins was on scene and made contact with the Anti-Crime Unit. It was determined that The Anti-Crime Unit would respond due to this incident being a suspicious death with the possibility of it being an overdose, as well as the fact there have been several recent deaths that are suspected overdoses within the past two weeks. Anti-Crime Unit responded to conduct an investigation and spoke with the outreach worker, █████ who is responsible for everyone living in the residence. They requested and obtained a consent to search the room at which time a syringe and a white powder substance, suspected of being narcotics, was found hidden in a tissue box. There were also unused syringes found under Jason's mattress. See their supplement for additional information.

ID Officer K. Sprague responded and processed the scene, he collected Jason's phone, wallet and the narcotics found by Anti-crime. See his report for additional information.

During the investigation █████ made notification to Jason's mother, Lisa M. Percy about Jason being deceased. I responded to Lisa's residence in regards to the incident and she informed me Jason has a daughter who is a juvenile and he is not married. She explained Jason has been having major headaches and has a history of drug use. She stated he was supposed to be clean of drugs and working. I explained to Lisa that Jason's phone and wallet were collected. While speaking with Lisa I explained there may be information on Jason's cellular phone that may be pertinent to the investigation. I asked if she would be willing to give consent to conduct a forensic examination on Jason's cellular phone. Lisa read the Mobile Device Consent form which she indicated that she understood and signed indicating that she would give consent to conduct the forensic examination. She also understood she could stop the examination at any time if she wishes to. After obtaining consent for the cellular phone this information was supplied to

B. Laboy investigated a suspicious death which occurred at 1435 North Maple Drive. During the investigation an ID officer was requested to respond to the scene. Details: On 11/09/2020, I responded to the above location for ID purposes. At the scene I met with Sgt. Watkins and Ofc. B. Laboy who informed me of the above investigation. It should be noted the residence where the deceased resides is a halfway house where multiple subjects reside. The deceased was located inside his bedroom of 1435 North Maple Drive and he was identified as Jason Hill. The deceased was clothed and kneeling forward on the floor with his face directly on the floor. There was a small amount of blood around the mouth and nose of the deceased and his face had signs of lividity. No visible injuries or signs of foul play were observed at the scene and the contents of the deceased bedroom were organized and did not appear to have been disturbed. Using a department issued digital camera, I took photographs of the area where the deceased as well as photographs of the deceased. A cell phone

was located on the bed which is believed to belong to the deceased which was also photographed. No evidence was located at that time pertaining to the investigation. Southern Regional Medical Examiner Aimee Rohrbach arrived the scene when additional photographs were taken of the deceased once the body was able to be moved.

The manager ([REDACTED]) for the residence arrived at the scene and authorized a consent to search for the bedroom of the deceased. The cell phone on the bed was collected by me as evidence. The wallet belonging to the deceased was also located and collected by me until the next of kin was able to be located and the property turned over to them. During a search of the bedroom, DSgt. J. Day of the Anti-Crime Unit of this agency searched and located a hypodermic syringe along with a small folded foil wrapper containing a white powder, believed to be CDS. The evidence was photographed by me and collected as evidence. No additional evidence was located at the scene.

At the station, I was informed by Ofc. B. Laboy he made contact with the mother (Lisa Percy) of the deceased, along with Sgt. R. Watkins when she was notified of the above incident. Lisa signed the Mobile Device Consent Form authorizing this agency to search her son's cell phone for evidence pertaining to the above investigation. Once I received a copy of the consent form, I turned the cell phone over to Det. J. Soler of the Anti-Crime Unit, who was following up on this investigation.

The digital media card; hypodermic syringe and the foil wrapper containing suspected CDS was tagged as evidence and turned over to Det. E. Ocasio of the Crime Scene Unit of this agency.

Laboy #9584 Incident Date: 20-11/09/2020 Supplement CAD # 20-65656 Synopsis: On the morning of November 9, 2020, Patrol Officer, B. Laboy was dispatched to 1435 N. Maple Drive regarding a subject unconscious and not breathing. Upon Officer Laboy's arrival, he observed personnel from the Vineland Emergency Medical Services (EMS) working the male subject. Said subject would later be identified as Jason A Hill. Officer Laboy indicated in his report that Vineland EMS contacted Doctor Fiorosisky of Inspira Health Network who via telemetry pronounced Hill deceased at 07:25 A.M. Officer Laboy proceeded by speaking with Hill's roommate and caller, Robert E. Mason who provided Officer Laboy with information regarding this matter. For further details, see Officer Laboy's initial report. Details: Shortly after the abovementioned call was dispatched, DSgt. J. Day and I responded to said location. Upon our arrival, I met with Officer Laboy who briefed me on the matter. As I spoke with Officer Laboy, I entered the residence which appeared kept and orderly. As I approached Hill's bedroom, I noticed he was slumped on the ground with his face resting directly against it. Based on my observation of Hill's body, it appeared as if he had fallen from the edge of his bed while in a seated position. As I looked around in the room, nothing appeared disturbed. Hill did not display any signs of injury and no signs of foul play were observed. I then spoke with Hill's roommates, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who provided me with a similar statement as the ones given to Officer Laboy. In speaking with Mason, he provided me with contact information for Michael Newcomb who is their outreach worker. I contacted [REDACTED] via his cell phone, who stated that he had been made aware of the incident by [REDACTED] and was enroute to our location (1435 N. Maple drive). Once [REDACTED] arrived, he stated that Hill had recently been placed at this location and appeared to have been doing well with no known drug use and/or issues. Next, I asked [REDACTED] if he would provide this department with consent to search Jason's bedroom in efforts to locate anything of evidential value to this investigation. During the search of Jason's bedroom DSgt. J. Day located one hypodermic needle as well as a white powdery substance wrapped in the same foil found inside of a pack of cigarette. The items described above were located at the bottom of an open tissue box concealed by unused tissues directly over them. Vineland Police ID Officer, K. Sprague photographed said items and collected them as evidence. A black in color cell phone that was located on Hill's bed, believed to be his, was also collected by Officer Sprague and later turned over to me.

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After the search was conducted, Officer Laboy responded to 3730 S. Delsea Drive #27A, Vineland, NJ 08360 where he met with Hill's mother, Lisa Daly. While speaking with Daly, Officer Laboy informed Daly that a cell phone believed to be Hill's had been located and was now in the custody of this department. Officer Laboy explained to Daly the importance of the cell phone regarding this investigation and requested Daly provide this department with consent to conduct a forensic examination on it. Daly agreed and signed a City of Vineland Police Department Mobile Device Consent Form, providing consent to conduct such.

Daly would later respond to Police Headquarters, where I explained to her the process of this investigation. During my conversation with Daly, she stated that Hill had been "sober" (not using drugs) and doing well for himself. Daly also stated that Jason did not suffer from any medical conditions but, had been complaining to her of excruciating headaches within the past week.

Hill's cell phone was subsequently turned over to Vineland Police Detective L. Rodriguez who conducted the forensic examination on it. Once the examination was complete, I reviewed the contents of it, which did not reveal anything of evidential value. Daly was contacted and advised she could retrieve the cell phone

On 11/25/2020 I responded to South Jersey Panels (Hill's place of employment) where I met with Hill's former supervisor, [REDACTED] who stated that Hill was a well-liked guy who always volunteered to work late. [REDACTED] stated that leading to Hill's death, he did not display any signs of drug abuse as he was still coming to work on time and performing his work duties as expected.

Investigation to continue once new information is obtained.

Investigation at the scene revealed the male subject, who was later identified as Jason A. Hill, was located by his roommate [REDACTED]. See Officer B. Laboy's initial report for further details. Details: I was contacted by Det. Soler who requested assistance with having a mobile device examined. Det. Soler provided me with a copy of the consent form, which was signed by Lisa Percy. The consent form was submitted with Officer Laboy's initial report. Det. Soler provided me with the mobile device to be examined, which I placed in temporary storage locker #42 until it could be examined. On November 11, 2020, I examined the device. The device being examined was a Samsung Galaxy A11, Model SM-A115U. The device was powered "On." The device was already in airplane mode. The device was PATTERN locked; however, I was provided with the pattern to unlock the device. I did not notice any damage to the device. I prepared the device to be examined by placing it in developer mode. Internal settings that uniquely identified the device were documented and photographed. I changed the display screen settings from 2 minutes to 30 minutes (Setting>Display>Screen timeout>2 minutes>30 minutes). I then plugged in the device to the forensic workstation. I conducted a logical forensic examination on the Samsung Galaxy A11, Model SM-A115U, with International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) 356425114901118 and serial number R95N80D65RW. I was unable to locate a matching profile for this device. I utilized an Android Generic profile to examine the device. Several items such as calls, contacts (Contacts), device (General Information, and Installed Apps), files & media (Application Binaries, Archives, Audio, Databases, Documents, Pictures, Readable Files, Unrecognized, and Videos), locations (History), and messages (MMS and SMS), organizer (Calendar Events) as well as other files were extracted from the device. The SIM card installed on the device was examined. There was a Subscriber Identity Module (SIM) card on the device with an Integrated Circuit Card Identifier (ICCID) 8901240132773643236. The phone number associated with the device was listed as (609) 246-8857.
