On the listed date and time the undersigned and other patrol units responded to the area of 1113 Fernwood Ct on the report of a naked male rolling around on the ground. Upon arrival in the area the undersigned observed local residents waving and point to the side of building 11 on Fernwood Ct. It should be noted this building is in the same complex and in a close proximity to the initial address given to Police dispatch. Upon exiting my vehicle I observed what appeared to be a Hispanic male down on his hands and knees in the grass area next to the building with only a white sheet covering his lower half and another unknown older Hispanic male standing near him asking for our help. The older male informed the undersigned that he observed the male crawling on the ground naked and briefly covered his body with the sheet. At that time P.O. Conteras and P.O. Phommathep arrived at the scene and informed the undersigned that they previously had contact with the same individual and that he was severally mentally impaired and provided the undersigned with his address of 1128 Fernwood Ct. At that time P.O. Gliottone went to 1128 Fernwood Ct. and made contact with a caretaker (A. Kamara) who responsible for the male, later identified as Lou-Garrett Castillo.

At that time due to his residence being within a close proximity Officers attempted to assist L. Garret Castillo to his feet in an attempt to return him to his residence and remove him from the extreme cold. While assisting him to his feet Officers observed what appeared to be a injury/possible fracture to his lower leg area. At that time Officers assisted him back to the ground and informed Police dispatch of the newly found injury. I then observed a second floor window to the building wide open and believed that due to his mental impairment he possibly jumped from the window ultimately causing his leg injury. The caretaker arrived on scene and confirmed that L. Garret Castillo was confined to his room prior to this incident. Garrett Castillo was then transported to Robert Wood Johnson Hospital by E.M.S. for medical treatment.
