The official Records Custodian, Madelene C. Medina, received your OPRA request on September 1, 2023. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is September 13, 2023. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 7th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following: See attached OPRA request.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request.

1. Total number of body cameras currently deployed in the police department (4 pages).
2. Invoices of body camera purchases (20 pages).

These records are being transmitted to you via E-mail, as per your request.

With respect to your request for "date on which body cameras were deployed to any police officers for the first time (year and month)" and "dates of initial body camera assignment for each police officer currently employed," no records

exist. The Bayonne Police Department does not maintain a list reflecting this information.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.b., the cost associated with this request is no charge.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the City of Bayonne to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form.

The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
