Dear Requestor;

You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

Body Worn Cameras

Effective February 5 2022 at 7AM, pursuant to the New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines, the Warren Township Police Department will be deploying Body Worn Cameras (BWC) to every officer. The cameras will be utilized by all uniformed personnel during the performance of their daily duties as well as by plainclothes officers when applicable. The cameras will be used in accordance with the guidelines established by the Attorney General and the directive issued by the Warren Township Police Department. Officers will be equipped with the Focus X2 Mission Critical camera which will be affixed on their outer vest carriers positioned in the upper torso/chest area. The attached photos depict the BWC and the approximate placement on the outer vest carrier.
