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Officer Aug and I responded to the intersection of Ridge and Holland Mountain Road for a 3 Car motor vehicle accident (MVA). Prior to our arrival, Sgt. McGowan and Officer Myshkoff were on scene. Upon our arrival, Sgt. McGowan advised me Officer Myshkoff would be conducting the Standard Field Sobriety Test on an individual believed to be under the influence while driving. I made contact with Officer Myshkoff who conducted the SFST's with Mr. Charles Krause. After conducting the SFST's, Officer Myshkoff placed Mr. Krause (defendant) under arrest for operating a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. Officer Myshkoff placed the defendant in my patrol vehicle (14-E). I transported the defendant to Sparta PD. for breath test samples as our testing machine is inoperable and out of service.

Upon arrival, I entered Sparta PD's sally port. I placed my service weapon and Taser in a weapons locker. I placed my 2-way radio and body worn camera in my patrol vehicle. I placed the defendant in the processing room and handcuffed him to the bench. I placed my cell phone and smart watch in the patrol room.

The defendant was processed for a DWI and was read the implied consent form to which he stated "yes" to submitting samples of his breath. I observed the defendant for more than 20 minutes, before attempting to give samples of his breath. The defendant's mouth was checked for debris with negative results. He showed no signs of burping, belching, or vomiting. He also did not place his hands or fingers near his mouth during the observation period. I read the defendant his Miranda Rights which he advised he would speak with me. The defendant stated he had at least 4 alcoholic beverages containing tequila and/or wine. I conducted the breath test using the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. New and unopened mouthpieces were utilized for each of the tests. There were no cell phones, two way radios, or electronic devices near the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C. The defendant provided two efficient breath samples which returned a BAC of (.21). The results were entered in the NJ State Police AlcoTest Calculator and the levels were within acceptable tolerance.

The defend was provided a copy of the Alcohol Influence Report Form Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C
The defendant was released to the custody of his friend, Steve Pollard. Mr. Pollard was advised and provided a copy of the Potential Liability Warning form and signed as such. Nothing further.

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
