1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

NJ Reg. A39JZP was stopped at State Highway 35 and Greenwood Avenue for motor vehicle violations. The driver was identified as Lisa King and the passenger was identified as Jimmy Reed. While speaking with the occupants of the vehicle, I detected the odor of burnt marijuana emanating from the interior of the vehicle. During the course of the investigation, King granted her consent to search her vehicle yielding negative results. They were each searched for marijuana due to the odor of marijuana also being present on their persons. As I began the search of Reed, I observed a bag of Heroin protruding from his pants. In total, he was found in possession of 45 bags each containing suspected Heroin. Along with the heroin, I located three partially smoked homemade cigarettes each containing suspected marijuana. P.O. Russo searched King for marijuana and located a cellophane wrapper concealed under her bra strap containing suspected Crack Cocaine. Both were arrested and interviewed at headquarters at which time Reed admitted to giving the Crack Cocaine to King and possessing the Heroin with the intent to sell it. King then admitted to having the Crack Cocaine with the intent to sell it.

I/M St. John, N., through verbal communication with Felicia St. John, Derrick Beckett, Telquan Adams and Jimmy Reed conspired and attempted to have several letters containing Suboxone mailed into MCCI. I/M St. John, N. directed that these letters be addressed to inmates Beckett and Lopez from false return addresses. The letter to I/M Beckett was intercepted on 21 OCT 19, and had a hand written return address from John Jay Perrone, Esq, 464 Broadway, Long Branch, NJ 07740. This letter contained five (5) strips of Suboxone wrapped in plastic and concealed in the bottom seal of the envelope. The letter to Carlos Lopez was directed to be sent, but not intercepted.
