51. Narrative

DURING THE AFOREMENTIONED CALL FOR SERVICE, I RESPONDED TO THE LOWER TOWNSHIP POLICE STATION TO ASSIST DETECTIVE IAMES IN SUBMITTING MR CHEW TO THE ALCOTEST MACHINE.

WHEN I ARRIVED AT THE LOWER TOWNSHIP POLICE STATION, I REMOVED MY POLICE RADIO, BWC, CELL PHONE, TASER, AND DUTY WEAPON PRIOR TO ENTERING THE PROCESSING AREA.

I ASKED DETECTIVE IAMES IF HE HAD REMOVED ALL OF HIS ELECTRONIC DEVICES. HE ADVISED THAT HE DID.

THE SUBJECT UNDER ARREST, MR CHEW, DID NOT HAVE A CELL PHONE ON HIM. THE PROCESSING ROOM WAS FREE OF ANY FOREIGN ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

IN THE PROCESSING ROOM, I STARTED MY MANDATORY 20 MINUTE OBSERVATION PERIOD. I FIRST ASKED MR CHEW TO OPEN HIS MOUTH AND LIFT HIS TONGUE. I DID NOT SEE ANY FOREIGN MATERIALS IN HIS MOUTH.

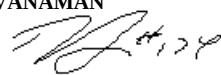
THE TIME I STARTED THE OBSERVATION PERIOD WAS 2215 HOURS. I KEPT A CONSTANT AND UNINTERRUPTED WATCH OF MR CHEW FOR THE DURATION OF THE OBSERVATION PERIOD. DURING THIS TIME, HE DID NOT BELCH, VOMIT, OR PLACE ANYTHING IN HIS MOUTH.

DURING THE OBSERVATION PERIOD, I READ ALOUD THE NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STANDARD STATEMENT FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS, NJSA: 39:4-50.2E.

I ASKED MR CHEW IF HE UNDERSTOOD TO WHICH HE REPLIED THAT HE DID UNDERSTAND. I ASKED MR CHEW IF HE WOULD SUBMIT BREATH SAMPLES TO WHICH HE REPLIED "YES."

I PREPARED THE ALCOTEST MACHINE, (SERIAL NO. ARWF-0389) WITH THE INFORMATION FROM THE CASE.

DURING THE "CONTROL TEST" OF THE ALCOTEST MACHINE, THE ALCOTEST ADVISED "CONTROL TEST FAILED." DUE TO THE CONTROL TEST FAILURE, THIS ALCOTEST WAS NOW INOPERABLE UNTIL A SOLUTION CHANGE WAS DONE.

MR CHEW WAS ADVISED THAT WE WOULD NOW NEED TO GO TO CAPE MAY CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO USE THEIR ALCOTEST MACHINE.

MR CHEW ADVISED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO GO TO CAPE MAY AND SAID THAT HE NOW NEEDED RESCUE TO RESPOND FOR PAIN IN HIS RIGHT ARM. WHEN RESCUE RESPONDED, HE DID NOT WISH TO SPEAK WITH RESCUE. HE REFUSED TO BE EVALUATED BY THEM.

AFTER SPEAKING MORE WITH MR CHEW, HE AGREED TO LET RESCUE CHECK HIS VITALS TO MAKE SURE HE WAS OK. RESCUE ASKED MR CHEW IF HE WISHED TO GO TO THE HOSPITAL. HE ADVISED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO GO TO THE HOSPITAL.

AFTER RESCUE DEPARTED THE LOWER TOWNSHIP POLICE STATION, DETECTIVE IAMES AND MYSELF TRANSPORTED MR CHEW TO THE CAPE MAY CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE SUBMITTED TO THEIR ALCOTEST MACHINE.

WHILE AT THE CAPE MAY CITY POLICE STATION, I ENSURED THE PROCESSING ROOM WAS FREE OF FOREIGN ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

IN THE PROCESSING ROOM, I STARTED MY MANDATORY 20 MINUTE OBSERVATION PERIOD AGAIN. I FIRST ASKED MR CHEW TO OPEN HIS MOUTH AND LIFT HIS TONGUE. I DID NOT SEE ANY FOREIGN MATERIALS IN HIS MOUTH.

THE TIME I STARTED THE SECOND OBSERVATION PERIOD WAS 23:41 HOURS. I KEPT A CONSTANT AND UNINTERRUPTED WATCH OF MR CHEW FOR THE DURATION OF THE OBSERVATION PERIOD. DURING THIS TIME, HE DID NOT BELCH, VOMIT, OR PLACE ANYTHING IN HIS MOUTH.

I READ NEW JERSEY ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STANDARD STATEMENT FOR MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS, NJSA: 39:4-50.2E AGAIN.

I ASKED MR CHEW IF HE UNDERSTOOD TO WHICH HE REPLIED THAT HE DID UNDERSTAND. I ASKED MR CHEW IF HE WOULD SUBMIT BREATH SAMPLES TO WHICH HE REPLIED "YES."

I PREPARED THE ALCO TEST MACHINE (SERIAL NO. ARWM-0040) WITH THE INFORMATION FROM THE CASE.

MR CHEW THEN SUBMITTED TWO PROPER BREATH SAMPLES THAT THE ALCOTEST ACCEPTED. BEFORE MR CHEW GAVE THE BREATH SAMPLES, I PROVIDED A NEW MOUTH PIECE PRIOR TO EACH TEST AND I READ THE BLOWING INSTRUCTIONS POSTED ON THE BOOKING ROOM WALL EACH TIME. MR CHEW EXPLAINED THAT HE UNDERSTOOD THE INSTRUCTIONS.

AFTER THE TWO BREATH SAMPLES WERE SUBMITTED AND STORED. THE ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT PRINTED AND ADVISED THAT MR CHEW HAD A BAC OF .33%. I RAN THE TESTS THROUGH THE STATE POLICE CALCULATOR. IT ADVISED THAT THE TESTS WERE WITHIN ACCEPTABLE LIMITS.

DUE TO MR CHEW HAVING A BAC OF ABOVE .30%, RESCUE WAS CALLED TO EVALUATE AND TRANSPORT MR CHEW TO CAPE REGIONAL MEDICAL FACILITY TO BE FURTHER EVALUATED.

A COPY OF THE ALCOHOL INFLUENCE REPORT WILL BE INCLUDED IN THIS CASE FILE.

THERE IS NO FURTHER INFORMATION TO REPORT AT THIS TIME. SHOULD ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION BECOME AVAILABLE, IT WILL BE DOCUMENTED ON A SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTIGATION REPORT.

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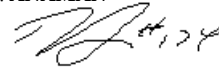
