Update to on the pro-bono legal services being received by the Middlesex County Recovery Community Center. The status is the same as last month, information was provided to the attorneys upon their request and they are in the process of filing the articles of incorporation to receive non-profit status. No filing fees have yet been requested from the attorneys.

MCRCC has fundraised \$1,395.22 so far, this funds should cover the filing fees, and have a small amount left over.

Updates were provided on the status of the 3rd floor space of Elijah's, which is where we hope to start the recovery center. We recently learned that there is some work that needs to be done to the space before it can be used. We are currently waiting to contact a church representative to inform us of the repairs that need to be made there is a report from the fire department which details the repairs needed. We are unaware if the cost is 500 or 5000 dollars. We will hopefully have word by January 25th.

It was determined in the meantime to reach out to some other organizations, mainly the church community, to see if there is possibly another space readily available. We will also be reaching out to the Moving Forward Wellness center to re-open a discussion about utilizing their space. The previous director Elena Kravitz just moved on from the center, and our contact may be Jay Yudof.

Joel is drafting a one-page document that may be used as a script describing the MCRCC and our efforts. This document will be sent out to the group listed below who will assist in outreach to gauge interest from possible organizations.

Joel is reaching out to the Middlesex assistant prosecutor for a contact for church organizations or a clergy association in Middlesex county.

James Johansen and Don Bornheimer will be reaching out to Abundant Life Church in New Brunswick.

Jenna Bonstein will be reaching out to Calvary Chapel in New Brunswick.

An update was provided on the nonprofit status of the recovery center. Becoming incorporated in January, the recovery center is working with Dechert LLP through Pro-Bono Partnership to apply for 501c3 status. The recovery center completed the SS-4 form to apply for its EIN number, which should be received in the coming week. Once received the recovery center is able to apply for 501c3 nonprofit status, and then for New Jersey Sales tax exemption.

The recovery center held its coalition meeting at The Moving Forward Wellness Center in New Brunswick. The recovery center is in conversation with Collaborative Support Programs of NJ (CSPNJ), who operate the 23 wellness centers in NJ. The recovery center board is discussing a possible MOU memorandum of understanding to collaborate with CSPNJ to possibly utilize the wellness center as their first operating recovery center. The wellness center currently operates 5 days a week from 1-4pm, being closed on Tuesday & Sunday. The recovery center is looking to operate outside their current operating hours.

Coalition members discussed the importance of identifying programming to implement when the center becomes operational, and performing outreach to raise awareness. There is importance on both sides of community involvement and available programming. There needs to be programming in place for people to attend, but also need people to attend in order to fill the programming at the same time.

Areas of focus for service/workshops were identified and include;

Housing, employment, emotional/wellness, physical/nutrition/wellness/yoga/meditation, education, recovery support groups, peer coaching, computer skills/job search, family education/support, among others.

It was discussed to have subgroups of the coalition to focus on certain areas including program development, recruitment, outreach/marketing, and volunteer coordination.

The next steps of the coalition are to be determined by the next meeting with the MCRCC board and CSPNJ, after an agreement is made about utilization of the wellness center.
