Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

At approximately 11:44 p.m., on May 3, 2018, Freehold Township received a call regarding a shooting on Route 33 westbound in the area of Halls Mills Road. Freehold Township patrol units immediately responded and located a vehicle which was stopped on the exit ramp from Route 33 heading towards Halls Mills Road. The initial officer, Patrolman Rich Gregg, located three individuals within the car; a driver, front seat passenger and a young child. Police immediately determined that the driver had sustained a gunshot wound to the head. Emergency medical personnel were summoned to the scene and the victim was transported from the scene. Despite attempts to treat the victim, she was pronounced deceased at 12:46 a.m. The victim was identified as 24 year old S.C. of Freehold.

Police identified the passenger as the victim's boyfriend, H.M. The child was identified as the one year old daughter of H.M. and the victim. On scene, H.M. told the officer that the involved vehicle was a white Impala, last seen heading westbound on Route 33. Patrolman Gregg had arrived at 11:46 p.m. and broadcast this through dispatch at approximately 11:47 p.m. In response, local law enforcement was made aware of this information.

H.M. provided a statement. He indicated in sum and substance that he and the victim were driving from Freehold to Neptune and turned around at Wal-Mart at Route 66 in Neptune because their headlights were malfunctioning, which forced them to use high beams. He indicated that, while heading back to Freehold on Route 33, they came upon a white Impala before The Cabin restaurant. In the area of The Cabin, the white Impala pulled over and let them pass. He said that the white Impala then came up on them aggressively. M eventually told the victim to take the Halls Mills Road exit because of the manner in which the vehicle was following them. H.M. indicated that the white Impala continued on Route 33, but as soon as it passed them, a shot was fired. He further described the vehicle as a white, beat up Impala with a greyhound logo on it, with tinted windows.

Addendum A

At approximately 11:44 p.m., on May 3, 2018, Freehold Township received a call regarding a shooting on Route 33 westbound in the area of Halls Mills Road. Freehold Township patrol units immediately responded and located a vehicle which was stopped on the exit ramp from Route 33 heading towards Halls Mills Road. The initial officer, Patrolman Rich Gregg, located three individuals within the car; a driver, front seat passenger and a young child. Police immediately determined that the driver had sustained a gunshot wound to the head. Emergency medical personnel were summoned to the scene and the victim was transported from the scene. Despite attempts to treat the victim, she was pronounced deceased at 12:46 a.m. The victim was identified as 24 year old S.C. of Freehold.

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Shortly after the response, members of the investigative team learned that Manalapan Police Department Patrolman Makwinski #143 was travelling on Route 33 West when he conducted several random license plate inquiries. While in the area of Millhurst Road and Route 33, the officer ran an inquiry at 11:41 p.m. on NJ registration. The registered owner of that vehicle was determined to be the defendant, Kader S. Mustafa, 174 Railroad Avenue, Heightstown, NJ 08520, DOB 6/14/81. The car was westbound on Route 33 at the time. The officer then saw the vehicle turn into a gas station. The officer continued to head west on Route 33. Shortly thereafter, Patrolman Makwinski learned through dispatch the information which had just been broadcast by Patrolman Gregg from Freehold Township PD regarding the shooter driving a white Impala. The officer then turned around and approached the gas station; however, the car was no longer there.

The Manalapan officer advised Freehold Police that he had run NJ , the white Impala, moments prior, corroborating H.M.'s description of the vehicle.

Law enforcement personnel continued to actively try and locate the involved Chevrolet Impala and Kader Mustafa. Ultimately, police located the vehicle, a 2004 white Chevy Impala, NJ Registration [redacted] the rear of a residence in Manalapan. Mustafa was located in the driver's seat, with a female in the front passenger seat.

Both Mustafa and the female, N.F. were transported to the MCPO for questioning. N.F. was interviewed and reported that she was involved in a dating relationship with Kader Mustafa. N.F. confirmed that Kader owns a white colored Chevrolet Impala. She advised that on Thursday, May 3, 2018, she and Kader went to the beach and Laundromat. N.F. explained that afterwards, she and Kader were driving around in the Chevrolet Impala and that Kader was ingesting Adderall. N.F. explained that while seated in the front passenger seat of the vehicle with her headphones on, Kader began to yell and turned the vehicle sharply to allow the car traveling behind them to pass. N.F. reported that Kader started yelling that the car was following them. N.F. explained that Kader accessed a gun, which was located between the driver's side door and seat and pointed it outside the window of the driver's door and fired one (1) shot at the vehicle that had passed them. N.F. advised that after Kader fired the gun, she observed the vehicle stop in the roadway and that she told him (Kader) that she suspected that the occupants in the vehicle were calling the police. N.F. advised that they drove to Kader's cousin's house in Manalapan and that they both slept in the car.

Search of the defendant's vehicle revealed two handguns, a Taurus .40 semiautomatic handgun and an S&W .38 revolver.

FIRST COUNT

MURDER

FIRST DEGREE CRIME

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths present that KADER MUSTAFA, on or about May 3, 2018, in or about the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of Murder, by purposely or knowingly causing the death of S.C., or by purposely or knowingly causing serious bodily injury resulting in the death of S.C., contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3a(1) and/or N.J.S.A. 2C:11-3a(2), and against the peace of this State, the Government, and dignity of the same.

FIRST COUNT - SENTENCING ENHANCER

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths also present that KADER MUSTAFA used or possessed a firearm while in the course of committing or attempting to commit the foregoing crime, or in the immediate flight therefrom, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:43-6c.

POSSESSION OF A WEAPON FOR AN UNLAWFUL PURPOSE

SECOND DEGREE CRIME

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths present that KADER MUSTAFA, on or about May 3, 2018, in or about the Township of Freehold, County of Monmouth, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of Possession of a Weapon for an Unlawful Purpose, by possessing a weapon, to wit: a handgun, with a purpose to use it unlawfully against the person and/or property of S.C., contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-4(a), and against the peace of this State, the Government, and dignity of the same.

THIRD COUNT

UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A WEAPON

SECOND DEGREE CRIME

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths present that KADER MUSTAFA, on or about May 3, 2018 and/or May 4, 2018, in or about the Township of Freehold and/or the Township of Manalapan, County of Monmouth, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon, by knowingly possessing a handgun, to wit: Smith and Wesson .38 revolver, without first having obtained a permit to carry same as provided in N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5b, and against the peace of this State, the Government, and dignity of the same.

FOURTH COUNT

UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A WEAPON

SECOND DEGREE CRIME

The Grand Jurors of the State of New Jersey, for the County of Monmouth, upon their oaths present that KADER MUSTAFA, on or about May 3, 2018 and/or May 4, 2018, in or about the Township of Freehold and/or the Township of Manalapan, County of Monmouth, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, did commit the crime of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon, by knowingly possessing a handgun, to wit: Taurus .40 semiautomatic handgun, without first having obtained a permit to carry same as provided in N.J.S.A. 2C:58-4, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:39-5b, and against the peace of this State, the Government, and dignity of the same.

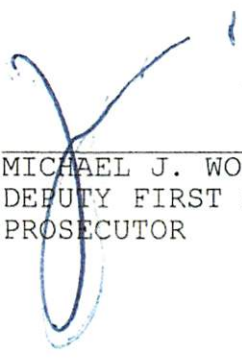
