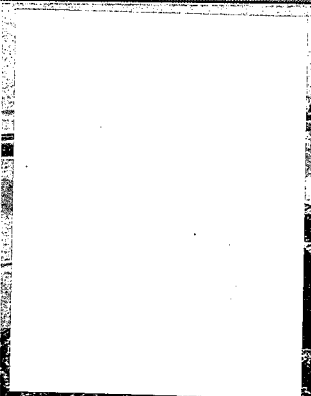

I immediately responded to the area of N Union St behind the CVS and observed a person riding a bicycle riding south from the area. As I closed the gap between myself and the subject I saw the color of the bicycle was green and the subject was wearing camo and blue jeans matching the description given to patrol. At approximately 17:37 hours, I conducted a pedestrian stop on the subject in front of 188 George St.

I asked the subject later identified as Carl A Decicco if he was at CVS recently which he replied no. I observed multiple bulges in his camo sweatshirt where the RP advised the suspect

had hidden the stolen items. I asked the male what was in his sweatshirt which he refused to answer. Det. Albani advised Decicco that we were investigating an incident. I told him if he cooperated we may be able to work with him. At that time Decicco pulled some of the items out of his sweatshirt however I could see there were still items hidden. I again asked him to remove the remaining items and he gave me a couple more. Again I still observed bulges under his sweatshirt and asked a third time which Decicco removed the rest of the stolen items from his clothing.

At approximately 17:40 hours, Det. Albani placed Decicco into handcuffs, and guided him into the back of my patrol vehicle 17-14. Det. Albani secured his seatbelt and I read Decicco the Miranda Warnings and asked him if he understood and he replied yes (recorded on BWC). I then transported Decicco to HQ to begin processing.

At 17:48 hours, I arrived at HQ with Decicco and processed him per department SOP's. Det. Albani fingerprinted and I charged Decicco with 2C:20-11B(1) Shoplifting a DP offense on Summons #S20250000121017. Decicco was then released after being told on BWC of his court date May 1, 2025 @ 13:00. All items were totaled up by CVS which came to \$32.91 then signed of on and returned to the store. 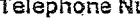
