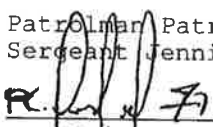

NARRATIVE FOR PATROLMAN PATRICK MOLINA

Ref: 18-551-OF

On Sunday May 27, 2018 at approximately 1931 hours, I responded to police headquarters for a landlord/tenant matter.

The reporting party, Joao Pinto (tenant), stated that his landlord changed the locks to his apartment. Mr. Pinto explained that he was away for the weekend and returned home today but was unable to enter the apartment due to the locks being changed. Mr. Pinto explained that he is unaware as to why the locks were being changed to his apartment and that he did not receive any notification from his landlord. Furthermore, Mr. Pinto stated that he has made numerous attempts to make contact with his landlord, Clarence (732.390.1898), with negative results. I was also unable to make contact with the landlord during this report.

Mr. Pinto was advised that a police report would be generated to document this matter and available for his record. Mr. Pinto was advised that this is a civil matter and that it should be reported with landlord/tenant court.



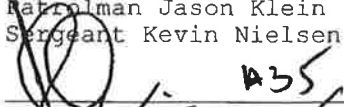

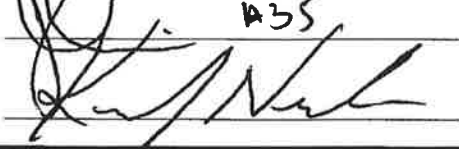

On August 29, 2018 at approximately 1445 hours, Sgt. Nielsen and I met with Glenn Lauritsen of the Borough of South River Code Enforcement Office.

Mr. Lauritsen stated that the residence at 2 Union Avenue had its electric and water turned off making the residence unfit for occupancy. He believed that the homeowner was still inside and taking electricity via an extension cord from the unoccupied home next to it located at 6 Union Avenue. Sgt. Nielsen and I told Mr. Lauritsen that we would investigate that situation.

We responded to 2 Union Avenue. From the street a long orange extension cord was running from the side window of 6 Union Avenue to an open window of 2 Union Avenue. The extension cord was at the least powering a window unit air conditioner. There were at least two canines inside the home. The resident, Carla Cardante, answered the door. Ms. Cardante stated that she and her husband, Manuel Cardante, were no longer married. She stated that she was moving to another location in New Jersey but her new home was not yet ready for occupancy. Until then, she stated that she has been staying at 2 Union Avenue. She said that her neighbor at 6 Union Avenue, Fabian Perea, was aware that she was taking his electricity to power her home, as her electric had been turned off. 6 Union Avenue was not occupied due to fire damage it received from the recent house fire at 8 Union Avenue. Ms. Cardante stated that her water had yet to be turned off by the town. We advised Ms. Cardante that she could not be in a home without electric and could not be taking electricity via the extension cord as it was a fire hazard. In fact, we observed the cord to be split with its wires exposed. Ms. Cardante subsequently unplugged the extension cord. She stated that she will stay elsewhere and only visit the house to remove the remainder of her belongings.

Sgt. Nielsen checked on the welfare of Ms. Cardante's twelve-year-old son, [REDACTED]. She stated that he has not been living with her, but has been staying with her eldest adult son. Sgt. Nielsen confirmed that Michael was in good health.

Ms. Cardante was advised that there would be extra patrol for the area of her home.

The town confirmed that Ms. Cardante did still have water inside the home.

Mr. Lauritsen was advised that we would document the matter.

I attempted with negative results to contact the homeowner of 6 Union Avenue, Fabian Perea, for the purpose of confirming that Ms. Cardante had his permission to take the electricity. I left a message for Mr. Perea to contact police headquarters regarding the matter.

On December 15, 2018 at 1348 hours, Ptl. Muszynski, Ptl. Nale, and I responded to 65 Ferry Street, Room 3A on a report that someone was burglarizing the room and was still inside.

Upon arrival, we were met by the building manager, Charles Niedermeier. He stated that someone other than the tenant accessed that room by breaking the door jamb. On Monday, October 28, 2019 at approximately 1323 hours, I (Ptl. R. Wright #73) responded to police headquarters for a walk-in report of harassment.

Upon my arrival I spoke with the reporting party, Valerie Mcconnon, who stated she was harassed at 8 John Street in South River. Mrs. Mcconnon stated she was harassed by her old landlord, Jeanette Meehan. Mrs. Mcconnon stated she recorded the incident and immediately responded to police headquarters to file a report.

Mrs. Mcconnon stated that she recently moved out of 8 John Street with assistance from a Veterans Affairs (V.A.) housing representative, Alicia McFarland. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that on Friday, October 25 she completed a walk through of the residence with V.A. McFarland before leaving so that Ms. Meehan could do the same. Mrs. Mcconnon stated she was advised by V.A. McFarland that the only issues the landlord, Ms. Meehan, had was with some recycling items, a bag of trash, and a vehicle battery that was left outside. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that she was advised by V.A. McFarland to go and retrieve all items except for the recycling, which would need to be picked up during the Borough's specified hours. Mrs. Mcconnon stated she subsequently responded to 8 John Street to retrieve the trash bag and battery while recording the incident.

Mrs. Mcconnon stated that upon her arrival to 8 John Street she took the trash bag and the car battery as requested. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that both items were located outside of the residence. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that before leaving the residence she was met by Ms. Meehan who happened to be driving past on George Street. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that Ms. Meehan stopped her vehicle and began trying to talk. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that she advised Ms. Meehan that she should not be talking to her. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that Ms. Meehan made a statement of, "we're putting harassment charges against you", before driving away.

I observed the interaction through video recording provided by Mrs. Mcconnon at police headquarters. I observed Mrs. Mcconnon's statements regarding the interaction to be true. Mrs. Mcconnon stated that she would like a report to be filed due to the history of harassment she has received from Ms. Meehan and the racist comments previously reported against her husband. I advised Mrs. Mcconnon that a report would be filed to document the incident.
