Hello Mr. Reimel,

My name is Paul (PJ) Buzzi Jr. and I live at 4205 Bridgeboro Rd.

This morning at 6:00 A.M. my family and I were woken up by a large flat bed truck that missed the driveway at 4200 Bridgeboro Rd and backed up in the street making noise with the back up beeper and banging in the driveway. Also I could hear a machine unloading the materials from the truck for 30 minutes from 6 am to 6:30 am. **6:00 A.M. is way to early for these types of deliveries.**

Furthermore just 2 days ago on 8/19/2020 2 tractor trailers filled with mulch made deliveries in 4200 Bridgeboro Rd. And 5 days before that a dump truck made a delivery. **This is not just an occasional deliver or occurrence as would be normal with a regular home owner. Rather these deliveries happen at least once a week if not more which is what businesses do.**
