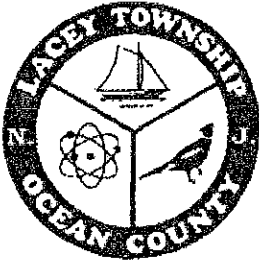
Re: Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station
