Mayor and Council Regular Public Session Minutes
Thursday, March 16, 2023, 6:30 PM, Civic Center

Mayor Dabal started the meeting at 6:32 PM by reading the OPMA meeting notice, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance and an invocation.

Roll call: Members Present- Ivanicki, Preinfalk, Androwis, Balik, Sadecki, Dabal. Members Absent- Rachelski. Borough Attorney Allen and Administrator Kazimir were present.

Hearing of Citizens: The meeting was opened to the public for comment.

John Rebecky- Expressed concern of cars running red light on Locust Ave.

Eugene Drzal- Requested the "use turn signal" sign be returned to the intersection of Main/Midland. Spoke about parking on grass ordinance. Sidewalk Conditions around Wallington.

Ms. Bielski- concerned about the parking lot at the Transfiguration Church.

Public session was closed at 6:52 PM with no other concerns of the public.

Communications: Motion to refer all communications to the proper agencies by CW Preinfalk, Seconded by CW Ivanicki. All communications were referred to the appropriate parties for their consideration by an affirmative vote of the 5 councilmembers. There were no votes against or abstentions.

Ordinance 2023-02: bond ordinance to appropriate an additional sum of \$425,000 for the construction of a new public library in, by and for the borough of Wallington, in the county of Bergen, New Jersey, to appropriate a public library contribution and authorize the issuance of bonds to finance such additional appropriation, and to provide for the issuance of bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance of such bonds.

A roll call vote was taken all 5 members present voted in favor of the Ordinance introduction. Vote passed 5-0-0.

 Certificate:
 - (a) This certificate should be executed in triplicate by the officials who sign the note, the seal of the Municipality or District impressed upon each of the three copies and the signatures certified by a local bank official before the note is delivered.
 - (b) This certificate must be dated as of the date the note is delivered.
 - (c) Please conform the copies of the note, attached to the copies of these certificates, to the original note by typing in the signatures of the officials who sign the note and by impressing the seal of the Municipality or District upon each copy of the note.

X 3. Form of Attorney's Certificate:

This certificate should be executed in triplicate by the Attorney for the Municipality or District and must be dated as of the date of delivery.

X 4. Form of Tax Certificate:

This certificate should be executed in triplicate by the financial officer who signs the note and must be dated as of the date of delivery.

X 5. Determination and Award Certificate:

This certificate should be executed in triplicate by the Chief Financial Officer and must be dated as of the date of delivery. The executed certificate must be presented to the governing body, and entered into the minutes in full, at the next meeting of the governing body after the date the note is issued.

6. Purchaser's Certificate as to Issue Price:

This certificate should be executed in triplicate by the purchaser of the note and must be dated as of the date of delivery.

X 7. Form of Approving Opinion:

We have enclosed a copy of our final approving opinion with respect to the issuance of the note, which will be sent by us to the purchaser of the note.

X 8. Form 8038-GC:

The Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, requires the filing of an information return with the Department of the Treasury within 45 days after the end of the calendar quarter in which the note is issued. The filing of such information return is necessary to ensure that the note remains tax-exempt. The deadline applicable to the note will be May 15, 2024. We have included two execution copies of the form. Please return one copy to us as soon as possible
