On May 2, 2024 at 0031 hours, I responded to Super Wawa on White Horse Pike for a report of theft. Upon arrival, I spoke with the manager on duty, Randall Smailer, who advised that the male stole two donuts (\$1.99 each), one Pepsi soda (\$2.69), and two pretzel packs (\$1.99 each), totaling \$9.63, after taxes. The male was described as an older black male with bad burns on his face; he was wearing a green shirt with black Adidas pants. Randall advised that the male was currently in the restroom. Assisting officers and I made contact with the suspect, Kevin Davis, who had locked himself in the bathroom stall with the items he stole. While assisting officers spoke with Kevin, I spoke with Randall, who stated that he did not want to sign a complaint at this time but did not want Kevin returning to the store. Randall stated that Wawa would sign trespassing charges against Kevin, if he returns in the future.

Assisting officers returned the pretzels to the store and Kevin was advised that he is no longer allowed at the store, and that if he returns, he would be charged with trespassing. Kevin left the area without issue. Randall provided me with a copy of the receipt, which was photographed and uploaded to the case.

Note

On 05/03/2024, at 1231 hours, Lindenwold PD was dispatched to 219 E. Gibbsboro Rd (Super 7 market), for a report of a shoplifting that had just occurred. Central Communications advised a black male, wearing a mask and a black shirt had stolen from the store and then ran off in the direction of the entrance of Woodland Village. I arrived at Super 7 and spoke with the complainant, identified as Selim Alam while Ptlm. Alexander circulated Woodland Village.

Selim stated a black male wearing a surgical mask came into the store and grabbed two plastic jars behind the counter containing approximately 70 Delta 8 Pre Rolls by Strictly Delta. The Pre Rolls were Girl Scout Cookies Hybrid valued at \$8.99 per roll totaling approximately \$629.30. The male did not use physical force against Selim to complete the theft. The male then ran from the store and towards the entrance of Woodland Village. Selim believed the male had parked a blue Toyota Corolla in the Woodland Village entrance.

I reviewed the surveillance video for Super 7 which showed the suspect. The suspect appeared to be a younger black male, with short black hair, a black surgical mask on. The male was wearing a black t-shirt with a blue box shape logo on it. He was also wearing a black button up outer layer, dark multicolor pants, possibly camo, with white socks and black and white Nike sneakers with white laces.

Selim stated he only wanted the incident documented and did not wish to sign complaints at this time.

Ptlm. Alexander and I circulated the area with negative results. The Gibbsboro Rd cameras were reviewed however the cameras that would capture the vehicle were not operating at the time. The Woodland Village cameras were negative for locating a suspect vehicle.

A VNF was completed for the incident.

05/14/2024 10:01	On Monday, May 13th, 2024, at approximately 1144 hours, Lindenwold Police units were dispatched to the Dollar Tree (1001 N Berlin Road), for a report of a shoplifting. Central Communications advised responding units that the suspect is a black male wearing gray sweatpants, walking towards the Lindenwold Patco station or the Somerdale Square. Patrolman Davis arrived on scene and made contact with the complainant. She advised via radio that the suspect had changed into black sweatpants, donned a purple jacket while behind the Somerdale Square, and should be in possession of miscellaneous food items. He was last seen walking West on the White Horse Pike into Somerdale. While canvassing the area, I was advised via Central Communications that Detective Wolcott of the Laurel Springs Police Department had a male, matching the description provided, stopped in front of A1 Auto (1100 White Horse Pike). Contact was made with Detective Wolcott and the male, later identified as Nashon Luseni, matching the description provided by Patrolman Davis. While conducting my fact-finding investigation, Mr. Luseni appeared nervous, would not maintain eye contact, and would provide ambiguous answers when asked where he was coming from/going to. He would only state that he is homeless and walks the White Horse Pike with no specific destination in mind. He was offered Volunteers of America services which he accepted on scene. A show-up was conducted by Patrolman Davis with the complainant. Refer to her investigation report for further details in regard to the show-up procedure. After the show-up concluded, I was informed that a positive indication was issued by the complaint, and Mr. Luseni was advised that he was under arrest. He was hand-cuffed behind his back, which were double locked and checked for fit, and escorted to my marked patrol vehicle (L11). Search incident to arrest yielded the following: Miscellaneous food items, one (1) tied black sock containing a master lock, one (1) tied black disposable bag containing a master lock, one broken clear/burnt pipe, and one spool of copper wiring. Mr. Luseni was secured in (L11), which was checked for contraband prior to my tour of duty, prior to securing Mr. Luseni, and after he was removed from the vehicle, with negative findings. He was then transported to police headquarters for processing, with my starting and ending miles broadcasted, via radio, to Central Communications. Upon arrival at police headquarters, my department issued service weapons were secured in gun locker #2 and a secondary search of Mr. Luseni was conducted, which yielded negative findings. He was then secured in Cell #2 without issue. Based on my training and experience, I recognized that the broken clear/burnt pipe, alongside the spool of copper wiring, is consistent with narcotics paraphernalia used to ingest crack-cocaine. Additionally, the tied black sock containing a master lock, and the tied disposable black bag containing a master lock, are consisted with self-made weapons, often utilized as blunt instrument weapons. Both the perceived narcotics paraphernalia and recovered food items were logged as evidence and secured in Evidence Locker #7. The perceived self-made weapons were seized and also secured in Evidence Locker #7. The key to Evidence Locker #7 was secured in the key lock box, as per departmental policy. Nothing further to report.
05/14/2024 09:50	On Monday, May 13th, 2024, Nashon Luseni was arrested after a shoplifting investigation. He was also found to have a \$350.00 ACS warrant out of Stratford Municipal Court. Search incident to arrest found him to be in possession of a broken, burnt pipe, along with copper wiring, consistent with narcotics paraphernalia used to ingest crack-cocaine. He was arrested and processed on Summons 0422 S 2024 000288 for 2C:20-11(B)1 and 2C:36-2, with a pending municipal court appearance on June 5th, 2024, at 1300 hours. An ROR was granted and issued out of Stratford Municipal court for 06/10/2024 at 0900 hours. See Patrolman Davis's investigation report for further details.

According to the caller, Pieter Roksnoer, the suspect was black male wearing a gray hoodie, and gray sweatpants. Upon my arrival, Pieter advised the male had changed clothing behind a building and walking west on the White Horse Pike. The male was described as now wearing a purple hoodie. I advised Central Communications and other police personnel of the updated clothing description. Laurel Springs Police advised they had the suspect (later identified as Nahshon Luseni) in front of A-1 Auto Shop. Other Lindenwold Police made their way to that location to detain Nahshon. Pieter advised he observed the suspect walking through multiple aisles placing merchandise including food item into his bags that he brought in. Pieter was read instruction from the Showup ID Procedure Worksheet and placed into the rear seat of my patrol vehicle (L-4) to conduct a show-up at A-1. While slowly driving by the location, Pieter stated "That's him!" I asked Pieter his level of confidence which he responded he was 100% confident. I advised the other personnel of Pieter identifying Luseni as the suspect and they placed him under arrest. Search incident to arrest yielded various items including two cans of Armour vienna sausage and two boxes of Brunswick Buffalo Chicken Salad with crackers (Pieter confirmed they sold those food items at Dollar Tree). Luseni was also found to be in possession of a crack pipe. The found items were placed into Evidence. Luseni was transported in a marked patrol vehicle (L-11) by Ptlm. Alexander that was checked and deemed clear prior to his transport. Luseni was found to have an active warrant for \$350 out of Stratford that was placed on a ROR. Luseni was processed and released on a summons for the shoplifting and poss. of paraphernalia (0422-S-2024-000288). Luseni was given a copy of both the ROR and summons. The merchandise and paraphernalia was placed into Evidence. Luseni advised LPD that he was homeless and Volunteers of America personnel assisted him with resources at Lindenwold Police Department.
