IT SHOULD BE NOTED THIS FOLLOW UP WAS PRE-SCHEDULED AND ONLY REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BE PLACED IN THE MAIL BOX, THEREFORE I WAS NOT EQUIPPED WITH A BODY WORN CAMERA. WHILE LEAVING THE FOLLOW UP AND WAITING TO TURN ONTO PINCKNEY ROAD, I OBSERVED A VEHICLE TRAVELING EAST ON PINCKNEY AND ONCE IT APPROACHED MY LOCATION IT MADE AN ABRUPT TURN ONTO SALEM LANE WITHOUT SINGLING IT'S TURN. ADDITIONALLY, I OBSERVED THE VEHICLES FRONT WINDSHIELD TO BE CRACKED AND THE BACK WINDSHIELD COMPLETELY BLOWN OUT. DUE TO THE MOTOR VEHICLE VIOLATIONS I REQUESTED A LOOK UP OF THE REGISTRATION FROM LSPD DISPATCH. DUE TO THE DELAY FROM DISPATCH I CONDUCTED A U-TURN IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE REGISTRATION AND I THEN OBSERVED THE VEHICLE PARKED IN THE MIDDLE OF SALEM LANE, RUNNING WITH THE DRIVER DOOR OPEN. WHILE WAITING FOR THE LOOK UP RESPONSE FROM DISPATCH THE VEHICLE THEN BEGAN TRAVELING BACK IN THE DIRECTION OF PINCKNEY ROAD. THE VEHICLE THEN CONDUCTED A LEFT TURN ONTO PINCKNEY ROAD AND BEGAN TRAVELING WEST. DISPATCH WAS ABLE TO PROVIDE A RESPONSE FOR THE REGISTRATION AND I INQUIRED IF ANY MARKED UNITS WERE IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO CONDUCT A MOTOR VEHICLE STOP WHICH NONE WERE. AT THIS TIME I CONDUCTED A MOTOR VEHICLE STOP WITH THE VEHICLE ON PINCKNEY ROAD NEAR BROAD STREET. ADDITIONALLY, I REQUESTED A MARKED POLICE UNIT RESPOND TO MY LOCATION. I EXITED MY VEHICLE AND APPROACHED THE VEHICLE ON THE PASSENGER SIDE OF THE VEHICLE AND MADE CONTACT WITH BOTH OCCUPANTS. I INTRODUCED MYSELF AND REQUESTED THE DRIVERS CREDENTIALS. AT THIS TIME I IDENTIFIED THE DRIVER AS SHAWN O'CONNELL OF TINTON FALLS. I ADVISED MR. O'CONNELL THE REASON FOR THE MOTOR VEHICLE STOP. IN CONVERSATION THE PASSENGER, LATER IDENTIFIED AS STACEY O'CONNELL, STATED SHE WAS MR. O'CONNELL'S WIFE. THE PAIR STATED THEY WERE OUT AND CURRENTLY MAKING DELIVERIES. [REDACTED] I RESPONDED BACK TO MY VEHICLE WHERE SGT. SCHERER #142 ARRIVED ON LOCATION TO ASSIST. I RESPONDED TO SGT. SCHERER'S PATROL VEHICLE TO UTILIZE HIS VEHICLES COMPUTER. WHILE DOING SO SGT. SCHERER RESPONDED TO THE...
