



**PROCLAMATION AMENDING THE STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY
DECLARED ON MARCH 15, 2020 TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE
CITY OF ASBURY PARK AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS AND BUREAUS
OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY OF ASBURY PARK:**

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, through Executive Order No. 103 (2020), Governor Philip D. Murphy declared both a Public Health Emergency and a State of Emergency throughout the State of New Jersey due to the public health hazard posed by Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); and

WHEREAS, to further protect the health, safety and welfare of New Jersey residents by, among other things, reducing the rate of community spread of COVID-19, the Governor issued Executive Order No. 107 (2020), on March 21, 2020, which established enhanced social mitigation strategies for combatting COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, also on March 21, 2020, through Executive Order No. 108 (2020), Governor Murphy declared that municipalities have the ability to impose additional restrictions in response to COVID-19 beyond the applicable provisions of Executive Order No. 107 (2020) relating to, among other things, "online marketplaces for arranging or offering lodging," and also stated that the State Director of Emergency Management "shall have the discretion to make additions, amendments, clarifications, exceptions, and exclusions to this list"; and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2020, the State Director of Emergency Management entered Administrative Order No. 2020-8 relating to "Hotels, Motels and Guest Homes," which provided that the Governor's Executive Order No. 108 (2020) is hereby amended "to allow municipalities and counties to impose additional restrictions in response to COVID-19 on the ability of hotels, motels, guest houses, or private residences, or parts thereof, to accept new transient guests or seasonal tenants after the effective date of this Order"; and

WHEREAS, the effective date of Administrative Order No. 2020-8 was April 5, 2020 at 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by N.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.5 and by ordinances adopted by the City of Asbury Park, and other relevant authority, a **STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY** within the City of Asbury Park was declared on March 15, 2020; and

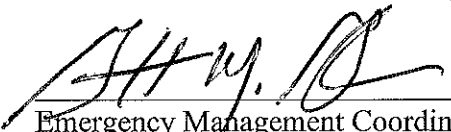
WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, regulations, and emergency management operations as are necessary to protect the health, safety, and resources of the residents of the municipality and to meet the various problems which have or may be presented by such an emergency; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the authority provided in the afore-mentioned Executive Order No. 108 (2020) and Administrative Order No. 2020-8, and the other laws referenced above, I

have determined that, in order to continue to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Asbury Park, all hotel, motel, and guest house reservations for lodging within the City must be canceled for a specified period of time pending a further determination relating to the safety of said public accommodations.

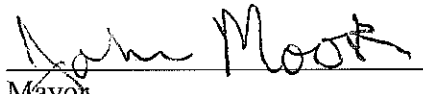
NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws and authority, given current exigent circumstances, I do hereby declare, in order to continue to protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Asbury Park, that all hotel, motel, and guest house reservations for lodging within the City are hereby suspended beginning on Friday, April 17th, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. I will continue to review this issue as matters progress following new guidance from the State of New Jersey regarding the COVID-19 State of Emergency, and this Order may be revised, dissolved, and/or extended accordingly.

THIS ORDER hereby amends and supplements the **STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY** within the City of Asbury Park which was declared on March 15, 2020 (as amended).
