PROCLAMATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

TO ALL CITIZENS AND PERSONS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT AND TO ALL DEPARTMENTS, DIVISIONS AND BUREAUS OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT:

WHEREAS, Section 4-8.1 of Borough of Keyport Municipal Code authorizes the Mayor to determine an emergency exists and to impose by emergency proclamation to declare a state of emergency whereby Mayor may impose a curfew; and

WHEREAS, Section 3-75.21 of Borough of Keyport municipal code empowers the Office of Emergency Management to proclaim a state or local disaster emergency and to issue and enforce orders to protect the health, safety and resources of the residents of the Borough; and

WHEREAS, peaceful assemblies are the lifeblood of our democracy based on the Constitutional rights guaranteed to all citizens of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, over the past week, individuals have engaged in legal and peaceful protests throughout the nation; and

WHEREAS, on June 6, 2020 a peaceful protest is scheduled to begin at 1:00pm at the border of the Borough of Keyport near Maple Place and Lower Main Street and proceed to the Borough of Matawan in support of social justice and police accountability; and

WHEREAS, the Keyport Police Department, the Keyport Governing Body, and the Borough of Keyport denounce the actions of the officers involved in the murder of George Floyd and any acts of police misconduct; and

WHEREAS, the Keyport Police Department, the Keyport Governing Body, and the Borough of Keyport, stand in full solidarity with the surrounding communities in promotion of a peaceful demonstration; and

WHEREAS, there still exists a state of emergency declared by the United States federal government and the State of New Jersey related to the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, residents are still encouraged to respect social distance guidelines, including the wearing of masks in public; and

WHEREAS, during recent events throughout the nation certain individuals have engaged in behavior that has endangered the health and safety of residents of their respective municipalities; and

WHEREAS, some civil disturbances have occurred nationally and in the State of New Jersey, endangering lives and property; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the safety of the organizers and attendees of the peaceful demonstration on June 6, 2020, certain precautionary safety measures will be taken; and

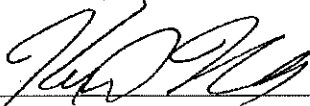
WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers vested in me by N.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.5 and by Section 4-8.1 of Borough of Keyport Municipal Code and Section 3-75.21 of Borough of Keyport municipal code, respectively, and other relevant authority, I have the authority to declare a STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY within the Borough of Keyport; and

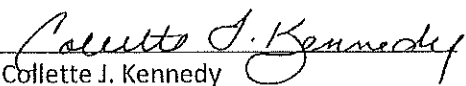
WHEREAS, the aforesaid laws authorize the promulgation of such orders, rules, regulations, and emergency management operations as are necessary to meet the various problems that might be presented by such an emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH the aforesaid laws, given current exigent circumstances, I do hereby declare, in order to continue to protect the residents of the Borough of Keyport, the following:

- 1) That a STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY exists within the Borough of Keyport
- 2) As part of the STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY, a limited curfew will be imposed for the Borough of Keyport beginning at 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, June 6, 2020 and shall expire on Sunday June 7, 2020 at 5:00 a.m. unless further extended.
- 3) During the hours of curfew, all persons are prohibited from using, standing, sitting, travelling or being present on any public street or in any public place, including for the purpose of travel, with the following exemptions:
 - a) All law enforcement, firefighters, paramedics or other medical personnel, as well as any other emergency response personnel authorized by the State of New Jersey, and credentialed members of the media.
 - b) Individuals traveling directly to and from work; attending religious services; commercial trucking and delivery services; obtaining food; caring for a family member, friend, or animal; patronizing or operating private businesses; seeking medical care or fleeing dangerous circumstances; and travel for any of the above services.
 - c) For purposes of this order, "travel" includes, without limitation, travel on foot, bicycle, skateboard, scooter, motorcycle, automobile, or public transit, or any other mode of transporting a person from one location to another.
 - d) For purposes of this order, "public place" means any place, whether on privately or publicly owned property, accessible to the general public, including but not limited to public streets and roads, alleys, highways, driveways, sidewalks, parks, vacant lots, and unsupervised property.
 - e) For purposes of this order, "exempt care" means necessary medical services for an individual's self or family member.
- 4) Residents are encouraged to continue to respect social distance guidelines, including the wearing of masks in public.

As declared by Borough of Keyport Emergency Management Coordinator, Kenneth Krohe and Mayor Collette J. Kennedy on June 4, 2020 to take effect June, 6th at 8:00pm through 5:00am June, 7th unless further extended.
