Portfolio Manager Updates

ENERGY STAR for Commercial Buildings and Industrial Plants

Deletion of Inactive Accounts and Properties

On February 19, EPA will delete inactive Portfolio Manager accounts and properties.

NOTE: This will apply to U.S. and international users *with the exception of those in Canada*.*

Your account and all its contents **WILL NOT BE DELETED** if either of the following apply:

- You have logged into your account in the past three years (since December 31, 2018); or
- Any of the properties for which you are the owner/Property Data Administrator (PDA) have been updated with new information (use details, meter data, etc.) by any account with shared access (such as via web services). If at least one of these is true, your data is safe and there is no action you need to take.

STILL NOT SURE?

If you're unsure if your account will be deleted, you can preserve your account and all of its contents by simply [logging into Portfolio Manager](#) by 11:00 PM EST on Friday, February 18, 2022.

**Accounts registered to a Canadian address will NOT be touched during this clean up. NRCan will be in touch with Canadian account holders in the future regarding their clean-up process.*

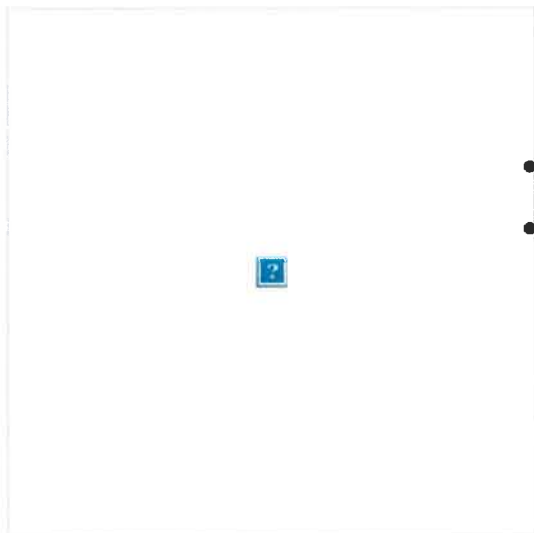

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) is seeking applications from interested individuals to be considered for appointment to the **Environmental Justice Advisory Council (EJAC)**.

Applications must be submitted by 5:00pm on March 15, 2022 in order to be considered. Non-electronic submissions must be postmarked by the application deadline.

The purpose of the council is to provide advice to the Commissioner of DEP on issues involving environmental justice and public health in New Jersey and to coordinate with

DEP and the Office of Environmental Justice (OEJ) in providing advice and guidance to executive branch departments and agencies.

The 18-member council represents a diverse range of stakeholder sectors and viewpoints including four representatives of local grassroots or community groups, two representatives of statewide social justice/civil rights or labor organizations, two representatives of statewide environmental justice or environmental advocacy organizations, two representatives of faith-based organizations or state or federally recognized tribal governments or indigenous groups, two county or municipal government or planning professionals, two representatives of academia, two representatives of the public health sector, and two representatives of the business or industry sector.

There are six vacancies for three-year terms from 2022 through 2025 in the following sectors:

- Local grassroots or community groups (1 vacancy)
- State or federally recognized tribal governments or indigenous groups (1 vacancy)
- State-wide social justice/civil rights organizations or labor (1 vacancy)
- Public health (1 vacancy)
- Business or industry (2 vacancies)

The DEP values and welcomes diversity and applications from individuals of all racial, gender, religious, and ethnic groups and all geographic areas of New Jersey are encouraged.
