The Carteret Police Department's Official Records Custodian, Captain Jeffrey VanWoeart received your OPRA Records Act (**N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1**) dated, February 20, 2021. Items 1 and 2 were supplied by Captain Michael Dammann .. An extension was required for item 3 until June 17, 2021 and your response is being provided today

The following specific records have been requested:

1. Email logs for police officer LT John Kelly from 1/1/2014 to 3/31/2016.
2. Email logs for police officer Joseph Reiman from 4/1/2015 to 8/31/2017.
3. ALL Body camera footage for police officer Joseph Reiman from 11/21/2015 to 4/1/2016.

Records responsive to this request.

3. Your request for all body camera footage for Officer Joseph Reiman from 11/21/2015 to 4/1/2016 is being reviewed for legal compliance.

This OPRA request would require extensive research not permissible under OPRA and would require an inordinate amount of time. Would you like to refine your search to a specific date and time.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days by law, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Carteret Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint form.
