73. Narrative On September 1, 2013 I responded to the beachfront of 70th street for fireworks that were visible from the LBTPD headquarters. Upon my arrival I observed approximately 20 people at the beach entrance to 70th street observing the fireworks. I looked at the location of where the fireworks being shot off and a male later identified as Joseph P Pahlow and an unidentified female were standing next to the fireworks going off. I walked up to Mr. Pahlow informed him why I was there and asked him for identification. He had a beer in one hand and a cigar in the other hand. He appeared to be intoxicated. I performed a Terry frisk on Mr. Pahlow because he had a large bulge in his front left pocket. It was immediately identified as a wallet by feel. I had Mr. Pahlow put down the beer and the cigar. I then asked him again for identification. He asked me why and I stated he was under arrest. He then stated "I am not getting arrested and he began to run south on the beach where I knocked him down into the sand. I then radioed for backup. Mr. Pahlow was facedown in the sand and was resisting arrest by locking his arms underneath his body. I was able to extract his right arm from under his body and he released his left arm enabling me to cuff his left arm. He was then placed in Ptl Hildebrandt's car and transported back to HQ. 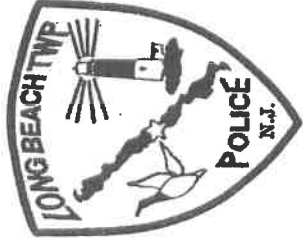

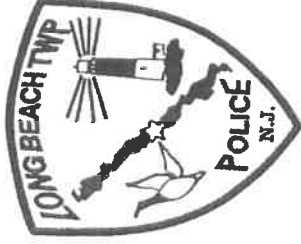
