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activated. I caught up to the vehicle in the area of 103rd Street and Long Beach Blvd and conducted a motor vehicle stop. I advised dispatch of my location and the vehicle registration (CT BK39359).

I approached the driver side of the vehicle, introduced myself as a Long Beach Township Police Officer, and advised the driver the interaction was being recorded. I explained the reason for the motor vehicle stop, and requested the driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. I asked the driver of the vehicle, later identified as Mr. Gennaro Bizzarro where he was coming from. Gennaro replied that he was coming from the "Black Whale," a local bar in Beach Haven. Gennaro's eyes were glassy and watery, and I could detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from within the vehicle. I asked Gennaro if he had anything to drink that night, which he replied no. While Gennaro was retrieving his documents, his hand movements appeared to be slow.

While speaking with Gennaro, he stated he was sorry multiple times, and that he was still getting used to the car. When I asked him how long he has had his vehicle, he said for a while. As I was attempting to return to my patrol vehicle, Gennaro called back to me stating, "These cars go really fast," and that he was again sorry.

I returned to my patrol vehicle and requested Patrolman Bazerque to assist. I also requested dispatch to check Gennaro for any active warrants, which yielded negative results.

Patrolman Bazerque arrived on scene. I returned to Gennaro's vehicle and requested him to step out of the vehicle to conduct Field Sobriety Tests. Gennaro was hesitant and became nervous. He stated he did not want to exit the vehicle. I advised Gennaro of the situation and he eventually complied. As Gennaro was exiting the vehicle, I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

While outside the vehicle, I explained to Gennaro that we would be conducting Field Sobriety Tests to make sure he was not driving while impaired. Gennaro stated, "I politely recline" from doing the tests. He also stated, "I'm good," and that he was not drinking. He again apologized for speeding. Patrolman Bazerque and I explained the situation to Gennaro for several minutes before he agreed to do the tests. It was made clear that Gennaro was choosing to do the tests on his own account.

Ptl. Bazerque administered the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test, which he advised me he had (4) four out of (6) six clues (See Improved Field Sobriety Checklist). During the test, I observed Gennaro to continuously sway back and forth.

Next, I explained and demonstrated the Walk and Turn test to Gennaro, to which he stated he understood all instructions. The results were as follows:

- Can't keep balance while listening to instructions
- Does not touch heel to toe on multiple steps
- Uses arms for balance
- Does not count steps out loud on first nine steps

I then explained and demonstrated the One Leg stand test. Gennaro stated he understood all directions. The results were as follows:

- Sways while balancing
- Uses arms for balance
- Puts foot down
- Not counting out loud
- Stops and puts foot down at nine one thousand and did not continue test.

I requested Gennaro to recite the English alphabet next, which he successfully completed.

Based on my observations, training and experience, I believed Gennaro was driving while impaired. I advised Gennaro to turn around and place his hands on top of his head, and placed him in handcuffs. While handcuffing Gennaro, I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

Before securing Gennaro in my patrol vehicle, I searched him, resulting in negative findings of any contraband. I then conducted a search of the interior vehicle compartment for intoxicants, yielding negative results.

Dispatch was advised Gennaro was placed under arrest for driving while impaired. A tow was requested to respond for a mandatory twelve hour hold as per Johns Law. Dispatch advised me South Shore towing would be responding.

Upon arrival back to Long Beach Township Police Headquarters, Gennaro was searched again with a

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hand-held metal detecting wand, yielding negative results.

Gennaro was read the New Jersey Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators form, to which he stated, "I understand, yes, I will," to providing breath samples.

Ptl. Bazerque conducted a twenty-minute observation and operated the Alcotest machine. Ptl, Bazerque advised me that Gennaro's B.A.C. was a .13%. The time of the traffic stop was 2311 hours, and the final reading was nearly two hours later. (See Patrolman Bazerque's Supplemental Report for further information).

An attempt was made to have Gennaro picked up from Headquarters, but was unsuccessful. Due to no one being available to pick up Gennaro, I drove him back to his house at 103 E 26th Street, in Ship Bottom. Gennaro had no other vehicles at his residence, and had no access to any other vehicles.

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On May 3, 2024 at approximately 2311 hours, S/O Cipriani requested me to back him up on a motor vehicle stop. He advised me he stopped a vehicle for speeding, observed indications of impairment with the driver, and detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage.

He asked the driver, Mr. Gennaro Bizzarro to step out of the vehicle. Mr. Bizzarro was asked to perform a series of Standard Field Sobriety Tests. He stated he did not want to perform the tests and that they were "designed to be failed." Mr. Bizzarro eventually agreed to perform the tests. I confirmed with him that he was doing so freely and willingly and wasn't being coerced to do so. He agreed and stated that he was doing so freely.

I performed the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test with Mr. Bizzarro and observed 4 out of 6 observable clues, including lack of smooth pursuit and max deviation, with angle of onset prior to 45 degrees not observed, as well as Vertical Gaze Nystagmus not observed.

S/O Cipriani performed the remainder of the tests with Mr. Bizzarro. After conferring with S/O Cipriani he placed Mr. Bizzarro under arrest for DUI. I advised dispatch we had a subject in custody for DUI and requested a tow and impound as per John's Law.

S/O Cipriani transported Mr. Bizzarro to police headquarters where he was placed in the holding room on the bench. While on BWC I read Mr. Bizzarro the Standard Statement and Implied Consent to which he stated "I understand, yes I will." I asked him to open his mouth and ensured that his mouth was free and clear of anything. I detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I maintained a constant uninterrupted visual of Mr. Bizzarro during which he did not belch, vomit or place anything in his mouth. I recorded the starting time on the 20 minute observation as 2350 hours.

Mr. Bizzarro was searched and was free of any electronic devices, I was free of all personal property and electronic devices. After a twenty-minute period, I continued my uninterrupted visual of Mr. Bizzarro and escorted him into the Alcotest room. He was placed in a seat while I prepared the Alcotest machine, (Serial # ARMK-0168). I advised Mr. Bizzarro of the instructions how to provide breath samples which he stated he understood. Mr. Bizzarro provided 3 breath samples with numerous attempts in breath sample 3, the results yielded the tolerance was out of range. Mr. Bizzarro appeared to be interrupting the sample by sticking his tongue out and appearing to touch it to the opening of the mouthpiece.

I switched to using the other Alcotest available (serial # ARMK-0010). After providing a sufficient breath sample, Mr. Bizzarro made a weird gesture with his mouth and exhaled, I asked him if he was okay and he stated yes, he just "burped up onions from his burger." I returned Mr. Bizzarro to the holding room bench and re-started the 20 minute observation process, at 0050 hours. After the 20 minute period I activated the Alcotest (Serial # ARMK-0010). I advised Mr. Bizzarro not to burp on purpose and that he was in jeopardy of being charged with refusal. Mr. Bizzarro provided an insufficient breath sample with minimum volume not achieved. His next sample yielded an error message of interrupted sample, again Mr. Bizzarro appeared to use his tongue to obstruct the mouthpiece. Mr. Bizzarro then provided 2 proper breath samples which yielded a BAC result of .13%.

After a review of the incident, Mr. Bizzarro's action and his clear intent to delay giving proper breath samples, it should be noted that Mr. Bizzarro could have been charged with refusal prior to obtaining a proper result. Mr. Bizzarro was turned over to S/O Cipriani and later released. Nothing further from this officer.
