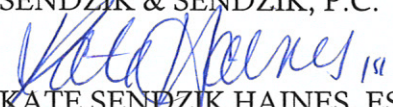

Your OPRA request sought access to the following: "Please produce the names of all firefighters who qualified for LOSAP and other incentives but never responded to an emergency call for years 2022, 2021. Also include any one who responded to less than ten emergency calls."

South Brunswick Fire District No. 3 has no documents responsive to the information you requested

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
