**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE
LENGTH OF SERVICE AWARDS PROGRAM**

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Washington that the section 59-4 of Chapter 59 of the Code of the Township of Washington entitled "Length of Services Award Program" be and is hereby amended as follows:

1. "§ 59-4. Estimated cost of program.

The estimated cost of the program has been calculated as follows, based on every member of each organization qualifying for the program:

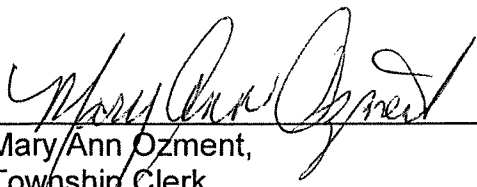
<u>Annual Remuneration</u>	<u>Total Cost</u>
\$1,250	\$96,000"

2. If any section, sub-section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

3. All Ordinances or any provisions of any ordinance inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies and not otherwise.

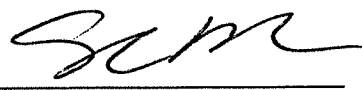

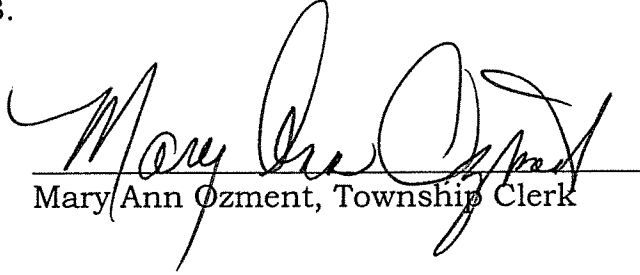

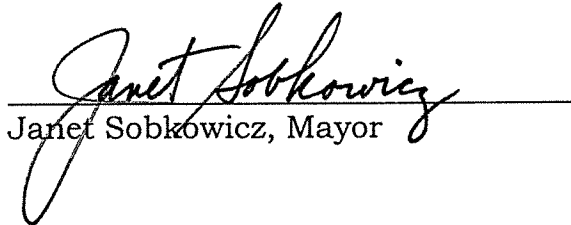
