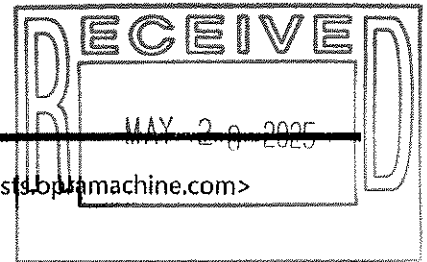

M.O. - The offender, identified as [REDACTED] year old male Tyrone Johnson of [REDACTED] Teesdale Street, Philadelphia, PA shoplifted \$789.98 worth of merchandise from 15 US 9 S; Best Buy without rendering payment on April 27th, 2024.

On Friday, May 10th, 2024, I, Ptl. Barina #182 responded to 15 US 9 S; Best Buy for report of shoplifting. Upon arrival, I met with the Store Manager identified as Amanda Muller who reported the following:

Amanda explained that on April 27th, 2024, at approximately 1106 hours, the offender later identified as Tyrone Johnson shoplifted approximately \$789.98 worth of merchandise. Items removed from the store without payment were the following:

- (1) Nest Doorbell-Wired : \$179.99
- (1) Nest Doorbell- Battery : \$179.99
- (1) Amazfit Trex2 Watch : \$199.99
- (1) Amazfit Balance : \$ 229.99

Patrols were able to review in store camera footage provided by Amanda at Police Headquarters which revealed the following: Tyrone is seen entering Best Buy at approximately 1106 hours in which he returns a video game at the front counter. After returning the video game, he is constantly seen looking over his shoulder for Best Buy Employees and other bystanders before quickly concealing multiple items on his person valued at a total of \$789.98 dollars. After concealing said items, Tyrone is seen leaving the store at approximately 1111 hours towards US Highway 9.

Amanda advised that the offender was identified and arrested for shoplifting at the at the Best Buy in Brick, NJ (51 Chambersbridge Road, Brick, NJ 08723) at approximately 1228 hours on the same date. Tyrone was caught wearing the same outfit as he was when he shoplifted from the Manalapan Best Buy. Patrols made contact with Brick Township Police Department in which they provided us their case number (#35432) in regards to their incident and verification of the offender Manalapan Township Patrols were able to positively identify him from the camera surveillance as he was wearing the same clothing in both theft incidents (Blue Shift / Black Jacket / Green/Black Hat). Additionally, Patrols were able to view photos provided by both Best Buy locations verifying the same. It should be noted that the distance from Manalapan Township to Brick Township is approximately 40 minutes - Manalapan Incident Time was 1107 hours while Brick Incident Time was 1228 hours.

Video surveillance footage provided by Best Buy was stored in Beast Evidence at Police Headquarters. Due to a lengthy criminal history for shoplifting, Complaint Warrant 1326 W 2024 000117 was endorsed against Tyrone. Best Buy management was provided with an incident number in reference to this incident. Pending future court proceedings.

MO: The offender, Nina Fiorillo shoplifted merchandise in the amount of \$35.77 from the Target Store by leaving the store without making payment. Nina was arrested and charged with Shoplifting in violation of 2C:20-11B(1) on Complaint-Summons: 1326-S-2024-000115.

On Saturday, May 4th, 2024, I, Ptl. Barina #182 responded to 55 US 9 South, the Target Store in regards to a shoplifting incident. Upon arrival, I met with complainant identified as Joelle Valdez (Loss Prevention Manager), who had a shoplifter in custody. Joelle reported the following:

Joelle related that today at approximately 1630 hours, a female subject entered the Target store and shoplifted several miscellaneous merchandise. Joelle explained that at approximately 1712 hours, the female subject exited the Target store without making payment for several items inside her shopping cart. Joelle advised he was able to stop the female subject from walking to her vehicle with the stolen merchandise and escorted her back to the Target security office.

While inside the Loss Prevention Office, I met with the accused subject identified as, Nina Fiorillo. Nina provided me with me with a NJ Driver's License and advised that she is the one on the surveillance cameras leaving the store with the shopping cart. Joelle stated that Nina left the store without making payment for the total sum of \$35.77.

Joelle was able to pull up the Target surveillance cameras, where I observed Nina walking around the store and loading her shopping cart with miscellaneous merchandise. Nina was observed to fill her cart and stop at the self checkout register. Nina then proceeded to scan only several merchandise items and not pay for two items. After Nina proceeds past the self checkout area and exits the front doors of the Target store. It is then to be observed that Joelle then exits his security office and confronts Nina of shoplifting.

In addition, Joelle advised that Nina appears to be the same individual that has been shoplifting in the past but Target has never reported any incident. Joelle recognized Nina from her appearance and alleges Nina always steals and does not ring up select merchandise from the Target store. Joelle related that he would be able to provide this Agency with previous non reported shoplifting incidents at a later time.

I requested Nina to stand up where she was searched and yielded negative for any contraband. Nina belongings were placed into her purse that was secured. I placed Nina under arrest for Shoplifting (2C:20-11). Nina was handcuffed behind her back, double-locked which was checked for proper fitting. Nina was placed in the rear of my marked patrol vehicle #26-17, seat belted in with the MVR on. Nina was transported back to the Manalapan Township Police Department Headquarters where she was removed from the patrol vehicle and brought into the booking room. The rear of my patrol vehicle was searched prior to and after the transportation yielding negative results.

Nina was fingerprinted and charged with the following on Complaint-Summons 1326-S-2024-000115: (2C-20-11B(1) - Shoplifting. Nina was checked through the Master Name Index and did not require a DNA sample test. Nina advised that she was not a veteran. Nina was read her Complaint-Summons and advised of her

upcoming court date. Nina received her appropriate copy of the Summons and was transported back to her vehicle at the Target parking lot without incident.

A copy of the Complaint-Summons, Arrest Report, Target Receipt, Beast Evidence Receipt, and Victim Property Loss Report are attached below in the Files section. NFA.

MO: Loss Prevention Manager reported that an unknown female suspect removed merchandise valued at a total of \$1,472.92 from the Home Goods Store on 05/02/2024.

On Saturday, May 4th, 2024, I, Ptl. Barina #182 responded to 55 US 9 South, the Home Goods Store in regards for report of a theft. Upon arrival, I met with complainant identified as Angelina Amato (Loss Prevention Manager), who reported the following:

Angelina related that on 05/02/2024 at approximately 1305 hours, an unknown female entered the Home Goods store and shoplifted approximately \$1,472.92 worth of merchandise. Angelina advised that the female walked around the store, filling a shopping cart with miscellaneous items. The female subject is observed to leave the store at approximately 1333 hours, with a shopping cart full of merchandise while passing all registers without paying for the merchandise.

Angelina requested this incident to be documented and also provided patrols with surveillance footage capturing this incident. Angelina provided a copy of the Home Goods receipt documenting the stolen items as well. The accused female on the surveillance cameras is observed to be wearing a black colored shirt and black baseball hat. A copy of the screenshots and surveillance footage has been entered into Beast Evidence. Home Goods management was provided with an incident number and a Victim Property Loss Report.

Back at Headquarters, I generated a TRAK message that has been sent out to surrounding Agencies in attempt to identify the accused subject. Attached below is a Victim Property Loss Report, Home Goods Case Report, TRAK message and a copy of the receipt for the stolen items. NFA.
