This response is being provided to you on November 13, 2023. Your OPRA request sought access to the following: "Produce all communication, emails, text messages, letters, notes of conversations where Commissioner Manobianco communicated to the Kingston Volunteer Fire Company, David Luck and all others about the District Special Board Meeting to be held on January 6, 2023."

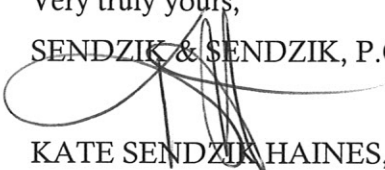
The South Brunswick Board of Fire Commissioners encloses the following records responsive to your request:

- (1) Email dated January 4, 2023 from Steve Manobianco to Kingston Executive Officers (1 page);
- (2) Email dated January 4, 2023 from Steve Manobianco to John Luck (1 page);

If you believe that your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, New Jersey 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your county.
