Dear Anonymous;

The Township of Warren received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 29, 2024. The Custodian of Records, Cathy Reese, received your OPRA request on May 29, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is on June 7, 2024. This response to your request is being provided to you on the (1) first business day after the Custodian's receipt of the request.

Your request is as follows:

- 1 - Communications to Warren Township officials between 2020-2024 of "any action that might compromise the confidentiality of the covered data and information" as per section 2d of the Marmic disclosure agreement.
- 2 - Communications to Warren Township officials between 2020-2024 regarding "any possible violations of the terms of their agreement" as per section 2f of Marmic disclosure agreement
- 3 - Communications to Warren Township officials between 2020-2024 regarding recommended security and software upgrades to communications and electronic devices. "

Response:

The request is overly broad and clarification is required. The requestor needs to identify the sender/recipient/subject matter. The subject matter needs to be provided and the senders/recipients need to be clarified. However, the Custodian desires to cooperate with the Requestor and asks the Requestor to modify the request to allow the Custodian to search for identifiable government records and not conduct research. Kindly resubmit this OPRA request with sufficient information to identify the government records sought.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Warren to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
