**RE: Opra Request for Access to Public Records pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1
Request by Anonymous Dated July 24, 2020**

Dear Sir:

Your three (3) opra requests for access to public records pursuant to the Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1, et seq., was received by the Custodian of Records of the Borough of Lavallette via email on Friday, July 24, 2020. Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic the NJ Governor extended the seven (7) business day response deadline to twenty-one (21) business days which would be Monday, August 24, 2020.

Your three (3) requests were for:

Copies of email logs for Mayor LaCicero, Chief of Police Colin Grant and Sergeant Justin Lamb from June 1, 2020 through July 24, 2020.

Copies of email logs should include sender, recipient, date and subject.

After diligent inquiry, the Custodian of Records of the Authority makes the following response to these requests.

The Custodian of Records does not have direct access to these email logs. Our IT person has not yet delivered these documents to me as of yet since he has been out of the office taking some scheduled vacation time. Due to this, the Custodian of Records is requesting an extension of time to respond no later than Monday, August 31, 2020.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Lavallette to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
