Good afternoon finance officers. I hope all is well. Earlier today, the New Jersey Association of Counties (NJAC), the New Jersey State League of Municipalities (NJLM), the Government Finance Officers Association of New Jersey (GFOA), the New Jersey Association of County Administrators (NJACA), the New Jersey Conference of Mayors (NJCM), and the New Jersey Municipal Management Association (NJMMA) sent the attached letters to Senate President Sweeney, Speaker Coughlin, and Chief of Staff Helmy asking for an in person meeting to discuss permanently extending the 2.0% cap on binding interest arbitration awards. Not only has the cap's expiration in 2017 inequitably altered the collective bargaining process in favor of labor, recent arbitration awards of double digit annual salary increases underscore the need to restore this critical tool for county and municipal governments across the State. Stay tuned for a model resolution and additional details.

Today Hillsdale Ave was unexpectedly closed coming from Royal Park- we are (apparently) not allowed to make a left onto Hillsdale Ave.

I spoke to the 2 Bergen County Sheriff officers & they said I should speak to "Hillsdale" about this.

I called the non emergency Police number & spoke with Officer Zimmerman & she was as surprised as I was.

She went over to the scene & then followed up with me to tell me, unfortunately, there is nothing the Hillsdale Police can do since it is a County Road.

This is a major street where on weekends I do all my errands in town etc... the only other way to get to town is to turn by Werimus Rd & Overlook - the problem and danger there -is there are multiple motorists constantly making very dangerous u turns by that Bridge- which is something I have voiced my concern about in the past - which is why I have avoided going that way in the past. (my Wife witnessed 2 of those turns today). So one thought of increasing safety there would be to potentially put a no U turn sign or have constant police presence there for safety.

I reviewed the Town Notice and there was no mention of Hilsdale Ave being closed coming from Overlook.

I was wondering if this is now permanent & also would want to clarify what hours & dates this is in effect since I have 2 children who both go to school in that direction.

Alan,

The HPD Chief of Police told me last weekend that the County Police made this decision for pedestrian & traffic safety reasons, based on the observations of the County police officers on duty. They apparently made the same decision this weekend as well. Both Hillsdale Ave and Werimus are county roads. I fully understand that this is an inconvenience to motorists (residents and non-residents), but is of limited duration. 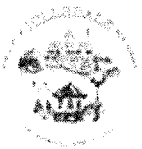

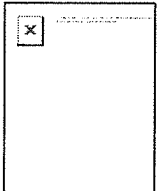
