I am filing the following request under the Open Public Records act.

- 1) Domain registration record of BrickPride.com A public search revealed the domain name has been intentionally hidden via private registration.
This request should contain.
 - a. Name of Administrative Contact of BrickPride.Com
 - b. Address of administrative contact of BrickPride.Com
- 2) I am requesting the following financial records pertaining to brickpride.com
 - a. Payment register for all bills paid by Brick Township for the operation of brickpride.com
 - b. Copies of all invoices pertaining to the creation and management operations of Brickpride.com (bills, invoices, payroll).
- 3) I am requesting copies of the following administration records pertaining to brickpride.com
 - a. Position and title of Jon Salonis along with salary and any ordinances/emails/actions approving this hire.
 - i. Job description of the position Jon Salonis holds within Brick Township.
 - b. A copy of the operational guidelines of BrickPride.Com
 - i. To include copies of emails sent from the mayor's office or business administrator's office containing the words "BrickPride.Com" between Dec 1, 2015 and March 22, 2016.
 - ii. Staffing roles of BrickPride.com
 1. Including: Name, position, salaries of each:
 - a. Photographer of Brick Pride.com
 - b. Editorial writer of BrickPride.com
 - c. IT administrator/web administrator of brickpride.com

The following questions are not being requested under OPRA.

I noticed today that there is a website called. "BrickPride.Com". It is my understanding historically that brickpride.com was a political/campaign website for Brick Township Democrats, so I was a little confused.

1. Who is the administrator/main contact point for BrickPride.Com
2. I was initially very confused about the use of the domain brickpride.com because over the years it has been synonymous with the Brick Township Democrat Club's campaign efforts. When I called to inquire about this, Jon Salonis answered the phone of the Brick Township Administrator, which further confused me. Can you (mr. mayor) explain this as he also operates a political blog and questions the credibility of the entire website. Please explain

Hi,

Sorry it took me a bit to see this. I am in Florida on vacation.

The opora part is being worked on by townhall.

I see you stumbled on our soft opening for our new township online newsletter. If we decide to formally launch it we will do a formal kick off in mid to late April or the beginning of May. We posted it earlier in order to get feedback and see exactly how it looks and works.

The name brick pride comes from our award winning twice a year newsletter that we started last year. The idea for the paper newsletter came from my senior advisory committee. They asked for a paper newsletter because a lot of them do not have computers or Internet so they do not have access to our awesome website or our Facebook page (over 18000 likes). I can send you a copy of it if you wish. Our next one goes to print in a few weeks.

Doing the online version basically writes the newsletter itself and also adds to my administrations philosophy of having transparent and open government.

I am not familiar with any connection between brick pride and the democratic club. I was a former president of the club in 2010 and 2011.

We originally interviewed for the position in December 2013 and January February of 2014. I then decided to wait to fill the position based upon seeing if current staffing worked out. We then interviewed candidates in summer/ fall of 2015. Jon was the top candidate and was offered the position. A condition that we set was he had to give up any and all political blogs. We are under the impression he did so. If you have other information please provide it so proper action can be taken. Jon started in mid January of 2016.

The contacts for the newsletter are myself Joanne Bergin the business administrator Ed Moroney our public information officer or Jon Salonis who does a lot of the postings.

Thanks for asking about our new initiative. If we go forward with the idea (I'm fairly certain we will) we will be one of the first in the state with an almost daily updated newsletter. Please look for our formal introduction and press release soon.
