RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, ON BEHALF OF THE MONMOUTH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ("MCOEM") AND THE MONMOUTH COUNTY SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS ("MCSPCA")

WHEREAS, through the Monmouth County Emergency Operations Plan, the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management works diligently to strengthen the County's preparedness to respond in the event of an imminent or declared emergency to preserve and protect the health, safety and welfare of the populace of Monmouth County; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to further improve the County's response to any disaster, the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management has recommended that the Board of Chosen Freeholders authorize Memorandums of Understanding with Private Sector Entities to provide assistance with such events as natural disasters, technological hazards, man-made disasters, civil emergencies, community disorders, biohazard emergencies, public health emergencies, insurgencies and/or enemy attacks against the County of Monmouth; and

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management has recommended that the Board of Chosen Freeholders authorize a Memorandum of Understanding with the Monmouth County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals for emergency domestic pet services to include but are not limited to staffing community evacuation or reception centers, rescuing, boarding, feeding, veterinary services, including related personnel, supplies, equipment and/or

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services ("Emergency Animal Services") from the Private Sector Entity in the event of an imminent or declared emergency by the Governor of New Jersey or by the MCOEM Coordinator.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Monmouth that the Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Monmouth, on behalf of the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management and the Monmouth County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals to provide Emergency Animal Services to the County of Monmouth in the event of an imminent or declared emergency be and is hereby accepted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Freeholder Director, or his designee, and the Clerk of the Board are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents on behalf of the County necessary to effectuate the full intent and purpose of this resolution, including the MOU referenced herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk shall forward a certified true copy of this resolution to the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office of Emergency Management; Office of County Counsel; and the Monmouth County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals, 260 Wall Street, Eatontown, New Jersey 07724.
