 practice will help you to create a state of

inner calm.

You can also help your body settle through
 calming touch. Try resting your left hand on
 your chest by your heart, and your right hand on
 either your belly or your forehead – whichever
 seems the most tense. Sense the support this
 supplies your body, allowing it to move into a
 more relaxed place. Many also find it helpful to
 place their right hand under the left armpit, by
 the heart and then place the left hand over the
 right upper arm and shoulder.

I invite you to try out these suggestions and
 see which is most helpful to you. In this way
 you can start to build a box of tools that you can
 use to manage your feelings during this pan-
 demic, or any other anxiety producing situation.

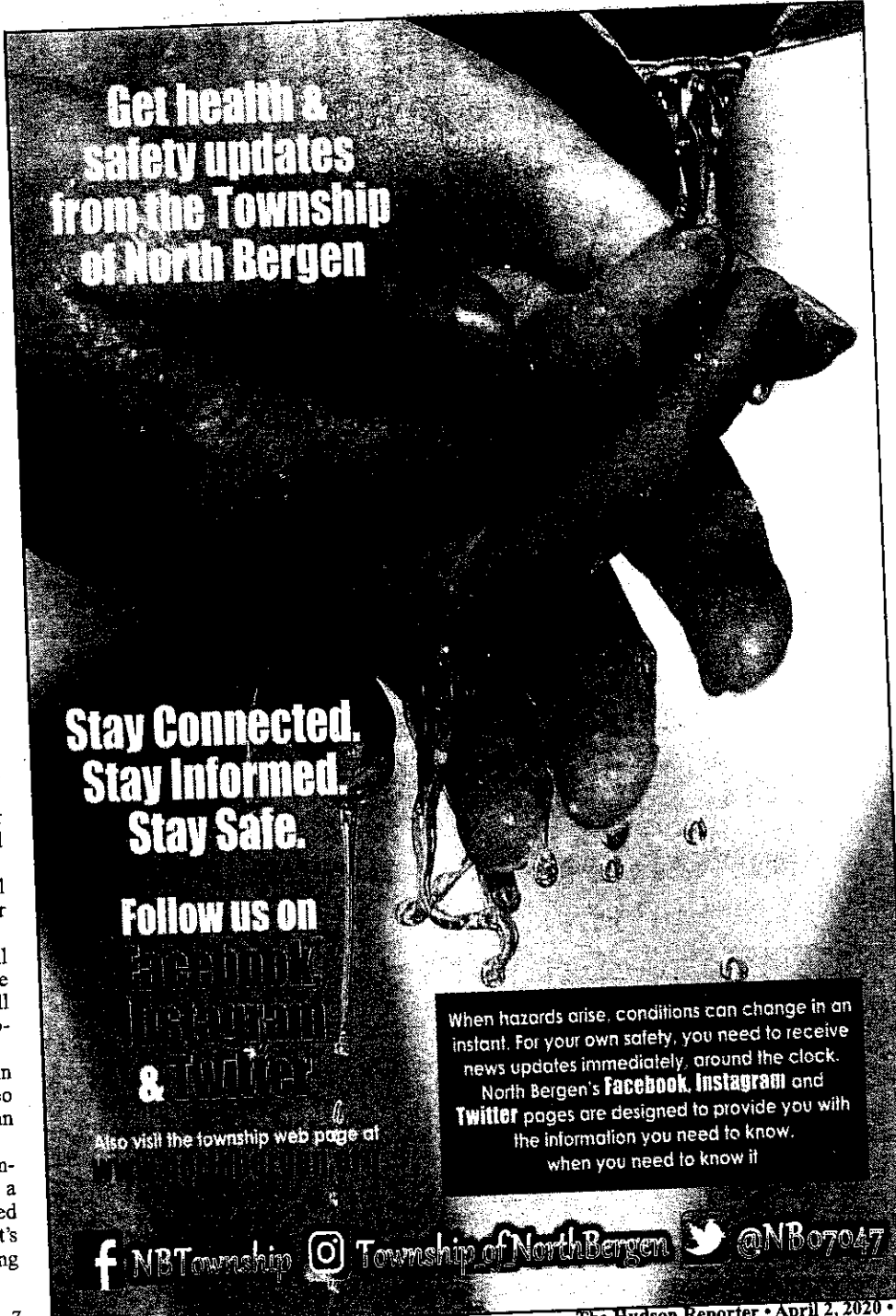

Obligations to report to probation officers in
 erson will be converted to telephone or video
 orting. Crime victims will be notified of an
 imate's release.

Grewal said the order creates a process to en-
 ure that inmates who are released will have a
 ife place to go, and that they are connected
 o the necessary help they need whether it's
 edical treatment or shelter or other housing
 ervices.

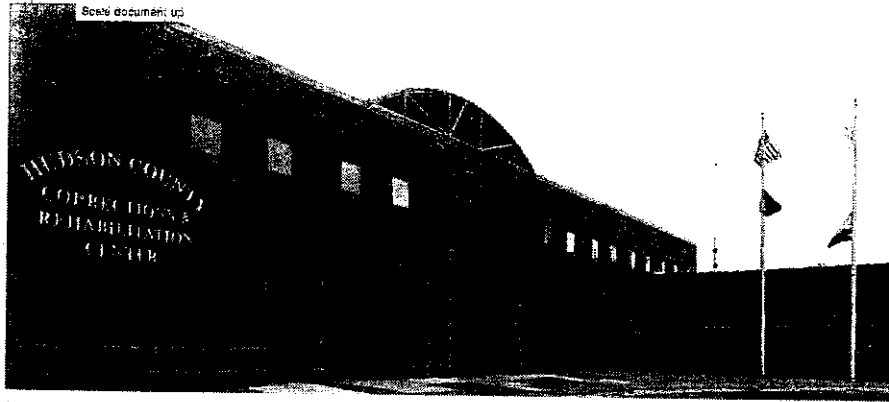

day's consent order," Grewal said. "But this is the most significant public health crisis we've faced in our state's history, and it's forcing us to take actions that we wouldn't consider during normal times."

"We know and we've seen across the river that jails can be incubators for disease, so we have to take bold and drastic steps. And so, when this pandemic concludes, I need to be able to look my daughters in their eyes to say that we took every step possible to help all the residents of this state, including those serving county jail sentences."
