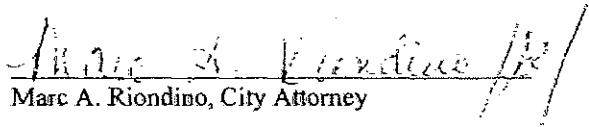

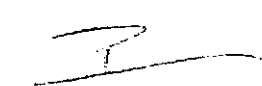

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRIBUTION PLEDGE AND SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ROWAN UNIVERSITY-RUTGERS CAMDEN BOARD OF GOVERNORS ("BOG") IN CONNECTION WITH THE CAMDEN CONSTRUCTION CAREER INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, the Rowan University-Rutgers Camden Board of Governors (BOG) desires to make a direct contribution to the City of Camden in the amount of \$90,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of Camden will also seek to contribute \$180,000.00 for this endeavor; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 authorizes local units of government to enter into agreements for shared services; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish the rights and responsibilities of both entities as it relates to the Camden Construction Career Initiative in the City of Camden; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Camden to accept the direct contribution of \$90,000.00 from the Rowan University-Rutgers Camden Board of Governors (BOG); now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Camden that the proper officers of the City of Camden are hereby authorized to accept a direct contribution of \$90,000.00 from the Rowan University-Rutgers Camden Board of Governors (BOG).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Camden that the Shared Services Agreement is hereby authorized between the City of Camden and the Rowan University-Rutgers Camden Board of Governors (BOG) for the Camden Construction Career Initiative.

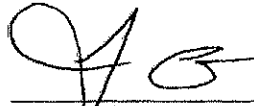

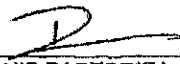

**CONTRIBUTION PLEDGE AND SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT
CAMDEN CONSTRUCTION CAREER INITIATIVE**

THIS AGREEMENT is made this 5th day of October, 2017, by and between the CITY OF CAMDEN ("City"), a municipality of the State of New Jersey, and the ROWAN UNIVERSITY-RUTGERS CAMDEN BOARD OF GOVERNORS ("BOG"), an instrumentality of the State of New Jersey. The City and the BOG are sometimes referred to herein singularly as a "party" or collectively as the "parties."

WHEREAS, the BOG is an instrumentality organized and established by the State of New Jersey pursuant to the New Jersey Medical and Health Sciences Education Restructuring Act, P.L. 2012, c.45, s.34 (N.J.S.A. 18A:64M-37, et seq.) ("Health Sciences Act"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Health Sciences Act, the BOG is authorized and empowered, among other things, to: (i) advance economic development, community engagement and education programs and to initiate and coordinate policies, plans and programs related to the health sciences, (ii) enter into contracts, exercise the right of eminent domain, and acquire, own, lease, dispose of, use and operate property, with a particular emphasis on spurring redevelopment in the City of Camden by expanding a health sciences campus anchored by the Cooper Medical School of Rowan University, and (iii) develop plans for the operation and governance of health sciences facilities, including plans concerning the development and financing of capital improvements or expansion of health science facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Health Sciences Act, the BOG is authorized, inter alia, to: (i) enter into contracts and agreements with the State or any of its political subdivisions or with the United States, or with any public body, department, or other agency of the State or the United States or with any individual, firm, or corporation, which are deemed necessary or advisable by the BOG for carrying out the provisions of the Health Sciences Act; (ii) accept from any government or governmental department, agency, or other public or private body or from any source grants or contributions of money or property which the board may use for or in aid of any of its purposes; and (iii) acquire, by gift, purchase, condemnation or otherwise, own, lease, dispose of, use and operate property, whether real, personal or mixed, or any interest therein, which is necessary or desirable for its purposes; and

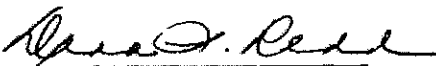
WHEREAS, among its other activities, the BOG is developing a health sciences campus as part of an "eds and meds" corridor connecting the Cooper Medical School of Rowan University with the campus of Rutgers University-Camden that will involve the construction of health science facilities within the City of Camden and create jobs for construction workers; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Cooper Foundation have formed the CAMDEN CONSTRUCTION CAREER INITIATIVE ("CCCI") to ensure that Camden residents are able

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be executed by the respective authorized representatives as of the date first written above.

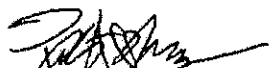
