Dear Mr. Boero:

Please accept this letter in response to your records request dated October 25, 2023. A request for a reasonable seven business day extension on the time frame for responding to your request was posed to you via email on November 6, 2023, making the due date for the response November 17, 2023. The records you requested in this matter are: (1) I am respectfully requesting a copy of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) however titled between the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office and the New Jersey State Police describing the roles and responsibilities agreed upon for the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office to participate in the Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force; (2) I am respectfully requesting copies of any and all instruction manuals and agreements used by the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office to report and memorialize the number of National Center for Missing and Exploited Children Cyber-Tips and arrests made as a result of those Cyber-Tips.

With regard to request (1), please find all responsive records attached as Responsive Record A. With regard to request (2), this office has no responsive records.

The Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office reserves the right to raise any other ground for denial not raised in this response. The failure of the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office to assert an exception or privilege does not act as a waiver of any ground for denial. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Cumberland County Prosecutor's Office to deny access. At your option, you may institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk.
