Dear Mansfield Committee Members:

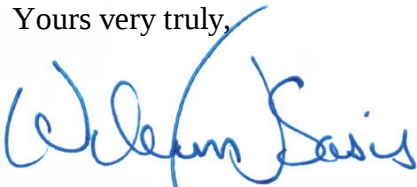
This is a follow-up to my March 10, 2021 letter regarding the toxic chemicals known as PFAS.

Attached is a Public Notice I received from The Borough of Waldwick, NJ regarding its drinking water.

Waldwick has a total of six wells that provide 100% of the borough's water. So understandably, this notice was likely sent because Waldwick owns and operates all six wells. But Mansfield has private residential wells and most people probably are not aware of the potential for PFAS contamination or possible solutions. Moreover, there's nothing preventing the Township committee from protecting the safety of its residents by warning them of potential contamination.

I urge that you work together with residents and other communities and set an agenda to educate the public regarding PFAS contamination in their drinking water.

Yesterday, the Borough held a Virtual Water Quality Meeting where our professional staff and technical experts provided information and answered questions about what the Borough is doing to ensure our residents are provided with quality drinking water. This meeting was in response to one of our water supply wells exceeding the NJDEP standard for PFOS, and followed up the March 1st public notice we mailed to all residents.

The presentation from our experts as well as the questions and answers with residents are a great resource for anyone who wants to learn more about the presence of PFAS in our system.
