Item #2 was clarified in my July 7th email. It seeks public records made by any "officer, commission, agency or authority" in the course of official business. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1.

A single letter from the Land Use Board is not a proper response. Only the Mansfield committee can enact Resolutions and Ordinances; not the planning board. As the custodian of records you should already know this. This is why during a prior public meeting before the committee I mentioned the need to train you on the *Open Public Records Act* so you could understand what a public record is and to help you stop dawdling. Honestly, it takes an unreasonable amount of time and coddling to obtain public records from you. It should be obvious that a letter from the Land Use Board about its review and conclusion of *Ordinance 2021-11* could only have been initiated and approved by the committee. Providing me with a copy of the ordinance is equally unresponsive and wasteful.
