OPRA Request

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Borough of Pine Hill received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 2, 2024.

The following is responsive to your request, with exceptions noted for denial on the actual documents being provided.

If your request for access for a Government Record is being denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, or as extended, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Pine Hill to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a procedure in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a Complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Com Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at GRC@dca.state.nj.us, or at its website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding Complaints filed in the Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.

No charge has been assessed for providing these records.
