Over the last few weeks, I have been approached by several personnel (both civilian and Police) regarding the mold conditions throughout the building. We have experienced several ongoing issues with climate control in the building and many of the vents have visible black mold. Furthermore, the men's and women's lockers rooms were severely affected by the recent condensation issue, causing many officers to have mold in their lockers and on their equipment.

My main concern is the health and well-being of all personnel working within the Police Department. Lt. Tomazic's health complaint is just one of many that I have received. I am not sure if these health issues are directly related to the mold, but I believe we should have the building tested and the affected areas thoroughly cleaned.

In inspecting my winter uniforms, coat, sweaters etc that have all been in my locker for some time all have mold on them. I have gathered everything from my locker to be laundered. Until they are cleaned I only have one uniform to work with.

Also I discovered mold on the front of my vest which I have wiped down with disinfectant from the patrol room but I want to make sure that is sufficient to kill the mold before I put it on. Lastly I have an inhaler in my locker from the smoke inhalation incident from the entering the house fire. That appears to have some mold like dust around the mouth piece and I don't want to put my mouth on it. I have thrown it away but I am requesting that Workmans comp please supply me with a new inhaler.
