78. Narrative While on uniformed patrol assigned to marked vehicle 904, I was traveling on North Park Pl. and noticed a wrong way driver stopped at the intersection of West Park Pl. and North Park Pl. At this point, I initiated my overhead lights to conduct a traffic stop for the above listed vehicle. I exited the vehicle, approached the driver, and instructed her to put the car in park. I could smell a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her mouth. I then asked the driver to exit the vehicle, shut the vehicle off, and to give me the keys. I observed the driver was incoherent, hysterical, had a slurred speech, and was unable to obey my commands. I immediately called for backup after the driver was refusing to obey my commands. During this time, the passenger Paula Costa stepped out of the vehicle and attempted to enter the driver seat. I instructed Costa to step away from me and return to the vehicle. Costa was eventually escorted away from the vehicle by Sergeant LaFera onto the sidewalk. After numerous attempts to instruct the driver to park the vehicle, she was eventually guided out by Sergeant LaFera. Once the driver Ariene Ellefsen was guided out of the vehicle she was instructed to walk to the sidewalk, where the ground was level and clear of any obstructions, so a series of Field Sobriety Tests could be performed. Due to the driver's level of intoxication, pre-exit testing questions could not be conducted. During Ellefsen's exit she appeared unstable on her feet and was staggering, swaying, and utilizing the light post for

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support. Ellefsen was crying hysterically, begging for help, and incoherent when speaking with her. While outside the vehicle I could once again smell a strong odor of an alcoholic flavored beverage emanating from her breath. I asked Ellefsen where she was coming from today and she advised Brazil and then from New Providence, since she advised she lives in Summit. I then asked Ellefsen how many drinks she had tonight, and she was unsure, but advised she drank wine with her friend Paula. Ellefsen's eyes were bloodshot and watery, and her speech was slurred. Further investigation revealed Ellefsen had left from The Laundromat Bar.

Prior to conducting the walk and turn test, I demonstrated to Ellefsen the proper starting position and how to properly conduct the test. During this time, Ellefsen advised she did not understand my instructions and began to move prior to advising her to begin and utilized the parking meter for support. When I instructed Ellefsen to begin, I observed her take 3 steps forward while holding on to the parking meter and did not count out loud. At no point did her feet touch heel to toe. She then began to lose her balance and stopped. I observed Ellefsen to begin swaying and having difficulty keeping her hands to her sides. Ellefsen could not complete the test due to her lack of balance and incoherent state. At no point did Ellefsen count out loud and she also had her arms raised more than six inches during the test.

One Legged Stand Test: The undersigned read the instructions and demonstrated how to properly conduct the test. I observed Ellefsen to be unsteady and swaying while listening to instructions. During the test, I observed Ellefsen to not follow directions at all. She did not count out loud or keep her hands to her sides and was once again unable to perform the test, due to her incoherent state. During my instructional phase I observed Ellefsen immediately become hysterical and beg for help.

Based on my training and assistance from senior officers, along with observations during the investigation and her SFST (Standard Field Sobriety Test) performance, Ellefsen was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated. Ellefsen was placed in double locked handcuffs and searched incident to arrest for contraband yielding negative results. She was then placed in the rear compartment of vehicle 904 which was searched pre and post transport for contraband yielding negative results.

PO Hanley stood by with the vehicle and waited for C&L Towing to arrive to impound the vehicle.

Once at 200 South St., PO Mazza read the NJ Attorney General Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators, and when asked if she would provide breath samples, she advised she would. PO Mazza assisted with the Alcotest instrument and advised after three attempts; Ellefsen was a refusal. She was then processed, fingerprinted, and then placed in cell five. She was later released to a sober party Eric Ellefsen who read, acknowledged, and signed the Potential Liability Warning (John's Law) paperwork. She was advised of her mandatory court date of June 3, 2024, at the Morristown Municipal Court at 1600 hours.

51. Narrative

While on uniformed patrol in vehicle 905 as the patrol supervisor, the undersigned responded to the intersection of W Park Pl./ N Park Pl. to assist P/O Winter on a motor vehicle stop where he stopped the above listed vehicle after observing traveling around the Morristown Green in the wrong direction.

After the driver Ariene Ellefsen was removed from the vehicle for not following directions and appearing visibly intoxicated P/O Winter began his DWI investigation (refer to P/O Winter's Investigative report). The undersigned then spoke with the sole front seat passenger, Paula Costa, who advised that they were both at the Laundromat Bar located at 4 DeHart St. together and that Ellefsen was upset and had been drinking this evening. Upon leaving the bar, Costa requested to drive but Ellefsen insisted driving the vehicle instead. Costa later left the scene after in an Uber after Ellefsen was arrested for suspicion of driving while intoxicated.

The undersigned then assisted P/O Hanley search the vehicle for intoxicants which yielded a metal cup with what appeared to be a small amount of red wine in it located in the cup holder.

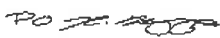

51. Narrative						
While on uniformed patrol in marked unit 916 and assigned to area one I responded to the area of West Park Place at North Park Place at the request of Ofc. Winter who was out with a vehicle who was driving against traffic on West Park Place. Upon arrival I stepped out with Ofc. Winter who was attempting to speak with the driver, Ariene Ellefsen, however her passenger, Paula Costa had exited the vehicle and was attempting to speak with Ofc. Winter. I then advised Costa to stand aside and stop interfering with Ofc. Winter's investigation which she complied with. At this time Ofc. Winter removed Ellefsen from the vehicle and advised her he would be performing some standard field sobriety tests on her. It should be known that Ellefsen was unsteady on her feet and was holding on to lamp posts and parking meters to steady herself. I then watched Ofc. Winter administer the walk and turn as well as the one leg stand test however due to her level of intoxication Ellefsen was unable to complete the tests. It was at this time Ellefsen was taken into custody for driving while intoxicated and transported to police headquarters, 200 South Street, for processing. Once at headquarters I assisted by acting in the capacity of Alcotest operator. After Ellefsen was uncuffed, I then inspected the interior of her mouth to ensure there was no foreign objects which was negative. Utilizing the time function on the alcotest instrument I began my twenty-minute observation period at 01:18 hours. During this period of time, I observed Ellefsen to ensure she did not ingest, regurgitate or place anything in her mouth that could compromise the reliability of the alcotest results. It should be known that all electronic devices including all body worn cameras, radios and telecommunication devices were removed from the room. I then read the New Jersey Standard Statement to Ellefsen who then agreed to provide samples of her breath for testing. For each breath sample I attempted to collect I used a new mouthpiece and read the AlcoTest Advisement to Ellefsen. Narrative On the above date and time, while on uniformed patrol in marked vehicle 901 assigned to post 1, I observed a White Mercedes-Benz Van with a NJ Reg XNPC75 traveling on James St towards South St. As the vehicle approached the intersection of James St and South St, I observed the driver make a wide right hand turn, drive over the double yellow lane and continued to drive on the opposite side of the roadway until he eventually drove back into the lane of travel. I continued to follow the vehicle and as we approached the intersection of Madison Ave and South St, I utilized my emergency lights to pull the vehicle over. The driver continued to drive down Madison Ave until we almost approached the 287 S entrance ramp which he then pulled over, hit the curb and stopped the vehicle. Upon approaching the vehicle utilizing my handheld flashlight, I observed the driver later identified Florjan Elezi. I immediately noticed an odor of an alcoholic beverage flavorings emanating from Elezi's breath and slurred speech. I observed Elezi with bloodshot and watery eyes, with a flushed face and he had slow and fumbling hand movements while handing me his documents. It should be noted, Elezi's drivers license and vehicles registration was actively suspended due to an uninsured vehicle. When I asked Elezi, where he was coming from, he told me "Morristown," I then asked him again where he was coming from, and he told me "Bayonne." While speaking, Elezi was slurring his speech, speaking incoherently and continually rambling on.

While Elezi was still in the vehicle, I conducted two pre exit tests which he ultimately failed. The first was the hand dexterity test, I instructed Elezi to touch each finger to his thumb and to count out loud. Elezi started the test while I was instructing him and when I asked him to wait until I finish, he then started again as I was instructing him for the second time. The final pre exit test was the countdown test, which I instructed Elezi to countdown from 85 to 63. Elezi counted as listed (85,84,83,82,81,80,79,78,77,76,75,76,75,74,74,75,74 then till 63). At this point I suspected Elezi was intoxicated and I escorted Elezi to an appropriate place to perform field sobriety tests. It should be noted, Elezi had an odor of an alcoholic beverage flavorings emanating from his breath outside of the vehicle as well.

I directed him to a flat level and lighted area suitable to administer the field sobriety tests. The first test I administered was Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test (the driver was not wearing glasses.) I first checked both eyes for equal pupil size and tracking, which was present in the left and right eye. I detected a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I then checked and detected distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I then checked and detected Nystagmus prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. I then checked for Vertical Nystagmus in both eyes. It should be noted Elezi moved his head and did not follow the stimulus with his eyes several times during the test.

The second test administered was the "walk and turn" test. I directed Elezi to stand in a "heel to toe," starting positioning, while I demonstrated and explained the rest of the test. During my instructions, Elezi struggled to get into the starting position, could not keep balance during my instructions and started the test prior to me telling him to do so. Once the test began, Elezi took 10 steps, stopped and could not finish the reminder of the test. During the test, he stepped off the line several times and did not touch heel to toe. It should be noted, during the test Elezi continually rambled on, had slurred speech and made several incoherent statements.

The third test administered was the "One Leg Stand" test. I directed Elezi to stand with his feet together and arms at his side, while I completed the instruction and demonstration stage. During my instructions, Elezi again struggled to stay in the starting position and started the test prior to me telling him to do so. As I explained the details of the test, I observed his body visibly swaying as he stood. Once the test began, Elezi stuck his right leg out, began to count incorrectly (1001,1002,1000,999,998,997,996) and put his foot down.

Based on my training and experience, along with observations during the investigation and his SFST performance, I determined Elezi was intoxicated. He was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated and double locked his handcuffs. I checked him for contraband with negative results and placed Elezi in the rear of 901. It should be known the rear of 901 was checked at the beginning of my shift, before placing Elezi in the rear and after removing him at 200 South St. I checked the vehicle for intoxicants which yielded negative results. PO Murphy stood by with the vehicle until Meslers Auto Body arrived.

Once at Headquarters Florjan Elezi was read the NJ Attorney General Standard Statement to which he replied "I refused," I then read the additional second line which he ultimately refused to provide breath samples. PO Mazza operated the Alcotest instrument, see his supplemental report for details. It should be noted while in processing Elezi spoke incoherently at times, continually rambled and his behavior went from excited to very calm and back to excited. It should be noted, while in processing Elezi's nose began to randomly bleed. PO Mazza and I then photographed, fingerprinted, processed and placed Elezi in Cell 1. He was later released into the custody of a sober party who read, acknowledged and signed the Potential Liability Warning (John's Law) paperwork. Meslers Auto Body impounded the vehicle and transported it to their secure lot where it was stored. I signed the following motor vehicle summons against Elezi and informed him of his mandatory court date 6/03/2024 at 1600 hours.

78. Narrative On the above date and time, while on uniformed patrol in marked vehicle 901 assigned to post 1, I responded to a head on collision on N Park Pl. Upon arrival, I observed a black GMC Yukon with a NJ Reg H71RXB on N Park Pl with heavy frontal damage to the right side of the vehicle. I made contact with PO Mazza who briefly advised me of the situation at hand and I was made aware that PO Alberto was conducting the motor vehicle crash investigation. See PO Alberto's MV crash report (2024-16854) for further details. As I was approaching the vehicle involved in a motor vehicle accident, I made contact with the driver a male later identified Ryan Daniel who was standing outside his vehicle with patrols. As I approached Daniel, I observed him with bloodshot, watery eyes and a flushed face. I immediately noticed an odor of an alcoholic beverage flavorings emanating from Daniels breath while he was already outside of his vehicle. When I asked Daniel, what happened tonight, he advised "I guess I went the wrong way in traffic". I then asked Daniel where he was coming from, he told me "Iron Bar." When I asked Daniel how much did you have to drink tonight, he replied with "I can't recall." While speaking, Daniel was slurring his speech, speaking incoherently and was swaying as he stood. At this point I suspected Daniel was intoxicated and I escorted Daniel to an appropriate place to perform field sobriety tests. I conducted one pre exit test which he ultimately failed. The pre exit test which I conducted was the countdown test, which I instructed Daniel to countdown from 85 to 63. Daniel counted as listed (86,87,88,89,83,82,81,88,80,62,63,64 and 65). I directed him to a flat level and lighted area suitable to administer the field sobriety tests. The first test I administered was Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test (the driver was not wearing glasses.) I first checked both eyes for equal pupil

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size and tracking, which was present in the left and right eye. I detected a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I then checked and detected distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I then checked and detected Nystagmus prior to forty-five degrees in both eyes. I then checked and detected Vertical Nystagmus in both eyes. It should be noted Daniel moved his head, did not follow the stimulus with his eyes several times during the test and placed his arms behind his back during the vertical nystagmus segment as to help with balancing.

The second test administered was the "walk and turn" test. I directed Daniel to stand in a "heel to toe," starting positioning, while I demonstrated and explained the rest of the test. During my instructions, Daniel struggled to get into the starting position, could not keep balance during my instructions and was swaying. Once the test began, Daniel took 10 steps, turned incorrectly and took 10 steps back. During the test, he stepped off the line several times, did not touch heel to toe, used arms for balance and took an incorrect number of steps. It should be noted, Daniel had a sleepy demeanor and continually staggered as he was walking.

The third test administered was the "One Leg Stand" test. I directed Daniel to stand with his feet together and arms at his side, while I completed the instruction and demonstration stage. During my instructions, Daniel had continual leaning and was swaying. As I explained the details of the test, I observed his body visibly swaying as he stood. Once the test began, Daniel stuck his left leg out, used his arms for balance, sways while balancing, put his foot down and at one point began to hop. Daniel put his foot down several times and struggled to finish the test.

Based on my training and experience, along with observations during the investigation and his SFST performance, I determined Daniel was intoxicated. He was placed under arrest for driving while intoxicated and double locked his handcuffs. I checked him for contraband with negative results and placed Daniel in the rear of 901. It should be known the rear of 901 was checked at the beginning of my shift, before placing Daniel in the rear and after removing him at 200 South St. I checked the vehicle for intoxicants which yielded negative results. PO Mazza stood by with the vehicle until Meslers Auto Body arrived.

Once at Headquarters Ryan Daniel was read the NJ Attorney General Standard Statement to which he provided breath samples. PO Ramirez operated the Alcotest instrument and advised me he obtained a reading of .20%, see his supplemental report for details. It should be noted while in processing Daniel spoke incoherently at times, continued to apologize and began to cry. PO Ramirez and I then photographed, fingerprinted, processed and placed Daniel in Cell 2. He was later released into the custody of a sober party who read, acknowledged and signed the Potential Liability Warning (John's Law) paperwork. Meslers Auto Body impounded the vehicle and transported it to their secure lot where it was stored. I signed the following motor vehicle summons against Daniel and informed him of his mandatory court date 6/03/2024 at 1600 hours.

According to the Alcotest instrument's time function my observation of Daniel began at 02:45 hours. I used the Alcotest time function to track the period of observation.

I observed Daniel's did not ingest, regurgitate or place anything in his mouth during the observation period that could compromise the reliability of the test results. All electronic devices including our body worn camera's, radios and all cell phones were removed from the room. Daniel's was read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators. At the conclusion of the statement, he agreed to submit samples of his breath for chemical testing. After the 20-minute observation period ended, I began my testing. I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIIIC and after the first successful test, I replaced the mouthpiece with a new mouthpiece and re read the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators. Once the test was complete, I called Morristown County Dispatch for the Alcotest calculator which verified that Daniel's was within tolerance. Daniels results was a BAC level of .20. I then assisted PO Hanley in processing Daniel's and placing him into cell 2 at 0342hrs. No further action taken.

Narrative While on uniformed patrol as the traffic safety officer in marked vehicle 901, the undersigned responded to Hillairy Ave for a report of a 3-vehicle hit-and-run crash without injury (see IR:2024-17008). My investigation revealed the following information. Upon arrival, contact was made with a crash witness Alejandra Colindres who advised she was inside her residence and heard the sound of a loud vehicle crash outside. Colindres advised she then went outside and witnessed a white car, later determined to be F66ULV NJ, fleeing the area with two observable damaged parked vehicles nearby on the side of Hillairy Ave. Colindres then followed F66ULV NJ and saw it park in a driveway (17 Hillairy Ave) up the street and observed the driver, later determined to be Robelio E Diaz Lopez, exit the driver's seat. The involved parties then returned back to the initial crash scene before patrol arrival. It was clear to me from damage on the parked vehicles that they were not operational and victims in terms of fault. Colindres had pieced pieced together that the offending white car (F66ULV NJ) had first struck a parked blue car

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(J52MUV NJ) and pressed the parked blue car into a parked black car (M10HWM NJ) before she exited her residence and followed the vehicle. Colindres account appeared rational and reasonable in consideration of the vehicle damage I observed. Colindres then identified the driver of F66ULV NJ, Diaz-Lopez, who was standing near the damaged parked vehicles. I next explained to Colindres the documents needed for NJTR-1 crash reporting and she advised she would provide the documents the following morning. I then made contact with Diaz-Lopez and when I asked him to show me his vehicle up the street, I observed his glassy and bloodshot eyes. Due to this observation, I asked Diaz-Lopez if he had drunk any beers tonight as best I could in Spanish. Diaz-Lopez denied drinking and P/O Rosado #159 was soon requested for Spanish translation. Diaz-Lopez also denied having a driver's license when asked at this time.

Patrols then escorted Diaz-Lopez and Colindres to the 17 Hillairy Ave driveway where vehicle F66ULV NJ on a white Jeep Cherokee was observed and had sustained a blown-out front driver-side tire and nearby damage to the area. I then requested Diaz-Lopez' driver's license, passport, registration and proof of insurance to which Diaz-Lopez complied and provided a Honduran passport along with the F66ULV NJ vehicle registration and proof of insurance. I next confirmed Colindres how she knew Diaz-Lopez was the driver of F66ULV NJ; and she confirmed she had first-hand observed Diaz-Lopez operating/exiting the driver's seat of F66ULV NJ. The scent of alcoholic beverage flavorings was detectable around the area of Diaz-Lopez and due to this fact-pattern along with his eyes and slurred speech, I decided to put Diaz-Lopez through Standardized Field Sobriety Testing.

P/O Rosado #159 next arrived on scene and all contact mentioned with Diaz-Lopez from this point forward was translated into Spanish by him. P/O Rosado #159 first gathered Diaz-Lopez' account of the crash, who confirmed he knew the crash occurred and advised he was driving half-asleep and made a right-turn onto Hillairy Ave. Diaz-Lopez again denied having any alcoholic beverages to drink and P/O Grawehr #190 responded and was apprised of the events so far. The rain then appeared to intensify so patrols moved the investigation to the dry awning of 13 Hillairy Ave to begin field sobriety testing.

P/O Grawehr #190 conducted the first test of Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Diaz-Lopez, despite the directions being translated to Spanish, kept moving his head initially and appeared to not be accurately tracking the stimulus (a pen) that P/O Grawehr #190 was using. Upon the eventual completion of the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test, I was advised all six clues were observed: lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes (2), HGN at maximum deviation in both eyes (2), and HGN onset before 45 degrees in both eyes (2). (Decision Point = 4).

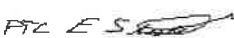
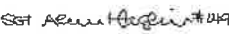
Due to the abundance of rain, Diaz-Lopez was then asked to complete the rest of the Standardized Field Sobriety tests back at 200 South St where it was dry and lit to provide him the best means of performing well. Diaz-Lopez complied, and I transported him in vehicle 901 to 200 South St for this action. Vehicle 901 was checked for contraband both pre and post transport yielding negative results. Upon arrival there-

P/O Grawehr #190 next reconducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test. Diaz-Lopez was re-explained the directions for this test and appeared to understand them. Upon completion of the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Test, the previous findings were confirmed, and I was advised all six clues were observed: lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes (2), HGN at maximum deviation in both eyes (2), and HGN onset before 45 degrees in both eyes (2). (Decision Point = 4). During this period, it should be noted the undersigned detected the odor of alcoholic beverage flavorings coming directly from Diaz-Lopez' mouth.

I next conducted the Walk-And-Turn Test. An unobstructed line of the ground of the 2nd sallyport was used to conduct this assessment. I recited the instructions directly from a notepad and demonstrated them; Diaz-Lopez advised he understood the given directions. I observed the following clues during this test: stops walking to steady himself, does not touch heel to toe, loses balance while walking, turns incorrectly, and incorrect number of steps. (Decision Point = 2)

I last conducted the One-Leg Stand Test. Here again, I recited the instructions for the test from a notepad and demonstrated them; and Diaz-Lopez advised he understood the directions while seeming overly-concerned with the number of seconds of the test. I observed the following clues during the test: sways while balancing, puts foot down, and cannot complete test (puts foot down three times). (Decision Point = 2) It should be noted Diaz-Lopez advised that he had knee issues in both legs however I did not believe this to be contributory to his test performance.

Due to the totality of circumstances observed, the undersigned placed Diaz-Lopez under arrest in double-locked

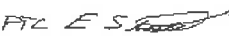

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handcuffs to the rear for suspicion of 39:4-50 DWI and escorted him downstairs to the processing room where he was searched yielding no contraband. Diaz-Lopez vehicle F66ULV NJ was next subsequently impounded at C&L Towing for a 12-hour minimum. A check through NCIC/SCIC also revealed no holds or warrants for Diaz-Lopez.

Diaz-Lopez was then played the N.J. Attorney General's Standard Statement for Motor Vehicle Operators in Spanish from the NJ Attorney General website and complied to undergo Alcotest breath test sample procedures. Alcotest operator Patrol Sergeant Hagelin #149 then began a 20-minute Alcotest observation window which ended with breath samples yielding a BAC of 0.19% under sequential file number 01558 (checked through dispatch for tolerance). Diaz-Lopez was then processed, and a sober party had already responded to Police HQ for custody transfer. This sober party/caregiver Nelly Ruth Diaz-Lopez signed a Potential Liability Warning accepting custody of Diaz-Lopez. However, Diaz-Lopez made vague self-harm statements (such as "see you in the next life") to P/O Rosado #159 during processing which caused patrol to request EMS be dispatched to the sallyport for mental health purposes. Diaz-Lopez was released on summons to Nelly Ruth Diaz-Lopez pending a mandatory court appearance of 06/04/2024 0930hrs and upon EMS contact, Diaz-Lopez was transported to the Morristown Medical Center Emergency Room where the undersigned advised charge nurse Mannino of the self-harm situation and Diaz-Lopez was ultimately lodged there for treatment.

I then conducted an inspection of his mouth cavity to ensure there were no foreign objects present. I then began the 20 Minute observation period and observed that he did not ingest, regurgitate or place anything in his mouth that might comprise the reliability of the test results. All electronic devices including body worn cameras were then removed from the room by Officers Rosado and Steele. I utilized a new mouthpiece for each test and read the Alcotest advisement statement, for each breath sample Diaz-Lopez provided. I operated the Alcotest 7110 MKIII-C which reported a breath test result of 0.19% BAC under sequential file number 01558. The EC / IR results were then provided to County Dispatch to run the Alcotest calculator who advised the results were within acceptable tolerance.

Davis explained the crash in regard to the other driver "she hit, and that was it." I asked Davis who crashed into who, and she replied, "I thought I was in my lane, and that's it." Davis was vague in her description of the events that transpired during the crash. After I input her driver's license number and vehicle information into my patrol vehicle's computer, I then responded back to Davis who advised that she had pictures on her phone of the crash. It then took Davis approximately five minutes to find her cell phone in her car to then show me pictures of where her vehicle was after the crash. Davis also used the rear portion of her car in what I thought was an attempt to stay balanced on her feet while she walked to the passenger side of her car to continue looking for her phone, which she found on her passenger seat. During the duration of Davis trying to find her phone, she would be

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unable to find it, and then proceed to stop looking for it for a moment. This led me to believe that she was having trouble focusing on the task of finding her cell phone.

I asked Davis where she was coming from today, to which she replied that she was coming from a massage appointment. Davis advised that prior to her massage, she had one single drink at 1200 hours while out to lunch. I was concerned that Davis may have been under the influence, to which I asked if she would be willing to participate in a few tests to determine if she was okay to drive or not. Davis did not have an issue with this.

I asked Davis if she went to high school and college, to which she replied that she did. I asked Davis if she was able to count from 1 to 100, to which she replied "yes." I then instructed Davis that I wanted her to count backwards from 52 to 37 upon me telling her to begin. Davis then advised that she could do it in English, Spanish, and in French. Officer Cerick #181 accompanied me on scene and asked Davis what language she was comfortable doing the test in, to which she interrupted him and began the test without being told to do so. Davis began the test and said "52, 50, 48, 46," and then said "40, uhm."

Patrols advised Davis that we asked her to count backwards from 52 to 37, and that we never asked her to count by 2's. In an effort to quell any miscommunication of the test, patrols readministered the test and told her to only count down by 1's. Davis then went on with the test and said "52, 51, 50, 49, 48, 47, 46, 44, 46, 45, 44, 44, 43, 42, 41, 40, 39, 38, 37, 36, 35, 34, 33, 32, 31." Davis was advised to stop counting at 37 and continued beyond that number down to 31. Davis advised "I'm really bad at math." It was at this time that Officer Cerick conducted the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus exam. Please refer to Officer Cerick's supplemental report for additional information.

At the conclusion of Davis being administered the HGN test, patrols found a nearby flat surfaced area that was well lit to conduct two more additional tests. Davis was asked if she had any issues with her knees, legs, hips, or back, to which she replied that she did not. Davis had on shoes with an elevated heel, and she was afforded the opportunity to take them off and participate in the tests while barefoot. I then advised Davis that she would be participating in the walk and turn test. I explained and demonstrated the walk and turn test to Davis. I advised her of the starting position, the heel to toe steps, the proper position of her arms (at her side,) and to count out loud. I asked Davis to take 9 steps on an imaginary line in front of her, to use a small series of steps to turn herself around, and to then take 9 steps going in the other direction. I demonstrated the test to her, and Davis advised that she understood the instructions.

I advised Davis that she may begin the test. Davis walked the first half of the test with her arms elevated from the side of her body. Davis did not count out loud any of her steps, and she took 11 steps, the majority of which were not heel to toe. Davis then turned around to walk back the other way, to which she took 13 steps, her arms now more elevated than during the first half of the test, and also with none of her returning steps being heel to toe.

I then advised Davis that she would be participating in the one leg stand test. I explained the instructions of the test to Davis: the starting position, arm placement, and the leg of her choosing being approximately six inches off the ground with her toe pointed out. I advised Davis to count out loud "one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three, etc" until I told her to stop. I also demonstrated the test for her. Davis advised that she understood the instructions, though she began the test prior to being told to do so.

I advised Davis that she may begin the test, and immediately she lost her balance and her footing and had to readjust back to the starting position. Davis then adjusted back to the starting position and put her arms up in the air while counting "one thousand one, one thousand two, one thousand three." After Davis got to "one thousand three," she put her foot down and had to restart. Davis then proceeded to say "one thousand four, one thousand five, one thousand six," before losing her balance and putting her foot down again. Davis then said "I can't do this one" before starting the test over and counting again from the beginning (one thousand one.) After Davis got to one thousand seven, she lost her balance and nearly fell.

It was at this time that I determined that Davis was unable to safely operate a vehicle. I placed Davis under arrest, and she was advised that she was being arrested for driving while intoxicated. I ensured that Davis's handcuffs were double locked. I brought Davis to my patrol car where she was searched for weapons and contraband, to which negative results were yielded. Davis was placed into the rear of my patrol vehicle, which had been checked for previous contraband left behind prior to my shift. I put Davis's seatbelt on for her and transported her to police headquarters at 200 South Street. Officer Rosado #159 arrived on scene and stayed with the vehicle, which was

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ultimately towed off scene by C&L Towing.

Upon arrival at police headquarters, Davis was removed from my patrol vehicle (which remained clear of contraband) and was escorted into our processing room. While in the processing room, Davis's property was logged onto a prisoner property sheet, and a copy can be found electronically attached to this report. I read Davis the New Jersey Attorney General's Standard Statement regarding breath samples, to which she replied that she would submit one.

Officer Cerick was to operate our department's alcotest machine and began the twenty-minute observation period. During this time, I read Davis her Miranda Rights to which she acknowledged and understood her rights, and I asked her the questions listed on the post-arrest DWI questionnaire, one answer of which contradicted the time of when she said she had her only drink at (she advised she consumed a beverage on scene at 1200, to later explain that she had a single drink at 1330.) At the conclusion of the observation period, Davis provided breath samples, which determined that her Blood Alcohol Content was 0.17%.

At the conclusion of providing breath samples, Davis was photographed/fingerprinted. Davis was given the opportunity to call a family member to pick up her up from police headquarters, and initially was unable to contact anyone willing to pick her up. Davis was placed into Cell #5. A prisoner cell sheet has been completed and can be found electronically attached to this report.

Officer Cerick was able to then make contact with Davis's son, Adam Winkler, who was at their home in Mendham. I was then advised that it would be permissible to release Davis to the custody of her son, and Davis was driven home by myself and Officer Barreto #194. Upon arrival at Davis's residence, Adam signed the John's Law liability form, which can be found attached to this report as well.

Davis was run for warrants with negative results. Davis's driver's abstract can be found attached to this report, as well as the other components of our department's DWI packet. Davis was issued two summons: 1424-E24-003887 for NJ 39:4-50 (Driving While Intoxicated,) and 1424-E24-003890 for NJ 39:4-97 (Careless Driving.) Davis was advised of the mandatory court appearance associated with the aforementioned summons. Arrest report completed. Vehicle impound sheet completed. I referred back to my BWC videos to recollect the incident.

51. Narrative

While on uniformed patrol in marked unit 909, I responded to the Dehart St parking garage to assist PO Moran with a crash investigation. Upon my arrival, he informed me he believed one of the individuals involved in the crash, Diane Davis, was intoxicated. He requested my assistance in investigating the incident as a possible DUI. We went and spoke with Davis who was standing near her vehicle. PO Moran asked her to perform a test and after the result of the test, we decided to conduct the standard field sobriety tests. See PO Moran's report for more information.

I began by conducting the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. Davis stated she did not wear glasses or contacts. I checked for resting nystagmus, which was not present in either eye, then I checked for equal tracking which was present in both eyes. Next, I checked for the lack of smooth pursuit which was present in both eyes. During the test, I had to remind Davis multiple times to follow the stimulus with her eyes the entire time. Her eyes would begin following the stimulus, then dart back the opposite way randomly. I then checked for nystagmus at maximum deviation which was present in both eyes. Next, I checked for nystagmus prior to 45 degrees which was only present in her left eye. Lastly, I checked for vertical nystagmus which was not present.

After I concluded the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test, PO Moran conducted the walk and turn, and one leg stand tests. At the conclusion of those tests and based on the totality of circumstances, Davis was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol, 39:4-50. PO Moran handcuffed her behind the back, and she was transported to police headquarters by PO Moran. I followed and assisted with processing and the utilization of the Alcotest instrument.

At headquarters, PO Moran read Davis the NJ standard statement and she agreed to provide breath samples. I then checked her mouth for any foreign objects with negative results. At 1920 hours, I began a 20-minute observation period to ensure she did not burp, belch, regurgitate or vomit to allow for any raw mouth alcohol to dissipate. Prior to beginning the tests, PO Moran removed all cell phones, radios, smart watches or any other devices that transmit wireless signals from the room. After he removed his belongings, I removed mine while he watched Davis. After 20 minutes of observing Davis, I began entering the information into the Alcotest instrument, then began the breath tests. Davis provided two adequate samples which returned a result of .17% BAC. After receiving the results, I contacted the Morris County Communications Center and had dispatch enter the results into the NJ State Police Alcotest calculator which reported the results were within an acceptable tolerance.
