On 06/02/2024 at approximately 2004 hours, I was dispatched to Walmart (934 S. Rt 73) regarding a reported shoplifting.

Prior to my arrival, central communications advised that there was a black female subject wearing a pink dress and blue jacket with red hair who left the store towards the Red Roof Inn with various stolen items.

Upon arrival, I observed the female subject walking with two other subjects in the parking lot of Red Roof Inn. I proceeded to stop the subject and subsequently detained her until officers could investigate the matter further.

I later identified the subject to be, Assiyah K. Haley-Johnson, and she was escorted to the rear of patrol vehicle #17. Ms. Johnson was read her Miranda Warning, and she advised that she would like to speak with officers regarding the incident. Ms. Johnson stated that while shopping, she was approached by loss prevention [REDACTED] at Walmart and was accused of Shoplifting. Ms. Johnson stated that she was about to pay for the items, but she became agitated when she was accused of shoplifting, so she proceeded to shoplift the items. The items were later found near a tree across from the Red Roof Inn parking lot and were returned to Walmart in sellable condition. Mr. [REDACTED] was able to provide officers with an itemized list of the items stolen that totaled to be \$96.75. Mr. [REDACTED] also provided officers with surveillance video of the incident.

Ms. Johnson was placed into custody at 2019 hours. Ms. Johnson was searched and seatbelted in the rear seat of patrol vehicle #17, where she was transported to MLPD Headquarters for processing. The rear seat of patrol vehicle #17 was checked before and after transportation for any contraband that yielded negative findings. Ms. Johnson was evidently fingerprinted and photographed, and I then completed an electronic complaint (0325S2024000438) against Ms. Johnson for shoplifting (2C: 20-11b(1)). The charge was ultimately placed on a summons.

Mr. [REDACTED] advised that she would like Ms. Johnson trespass from Walmart. I completed the Mount Laurel Police Trespass Notice Form, which Ms. Johnson signed, stating that she understood that she was not allowed to return to Walmart. Ms. Johnson

On 06/02/24 at approximately 2021 hours, I responded to 603 Fellowship Road (Red Roof) to assist patrol units who arrested a female shoplifter, later identified as Assiyah Haley. Ptl Farley #218 turned over the stolen proceeds to have them itemized at Walmart.

I arrived at the Walmart and turned over the recovered merchandise to the Loss Prevention Officer, [REDACTED]. I reviewed the surveillance footage and observed an unknown black male, later identified as Zakir Brown, assisting Ms. Haley with her shoplifting. Mr. Brown and Ms. Haley were accompanied by a second female later identified as [REDACTED].

Zakir Brown was observed in front of the self-checkout pretending to scan a wireless subwoofer. Ms. Haley was standing to his right-hand side and scanned a few articles of children's clothing. Mr. Brown paid for the clothing with cash and took the receipt. Ms. Haley took additional items (the stolen proceeds), bypassed the self-check scanner, and placed the items inside a blue reusable Walmart bag. Ms. Haley failed to pay for these items.

The Loss Prevention Officer, [REDACTED], stated that he observed this via surveillance footage and approached Mr. Brown and Ms. Haley at the check-out aisle. Mr. Brown immediately scanned the subwoofer, paid with cash, and took the receipt. Ms. Haley took the bag containing the unpaid items and walked out.

I exited Walmart and began to drive away when I observed Mr. Brown and Ms. White in the Walmart parking lot, walking toward the Red Roof parking lot. I conducted a pedestrian stop in an attempt to identify them. I notified dispatch and activated my overhead lights.

I approached Mr. Brown and Ms. White and explained that they were being detained regarding Ms. Haley's shoplifting for identification purposes. Mr. Brown and Ms. White identified themselves by name and d.o.b and advised that they stayed at the Main Stay Suites in room [REDACTED]. Mr. Brown and Ms. White began to walk away from my pedestrian stop. I explained to Mr. Brown and Ms. White that I had to identify them for the Walmart shoplifting investigation properly. Mr. Brown was advised that he was seen on

surveillance assisting Ms. Haley. Mr. Brown then ran away toward the Red Roof parking lot while I was identifying him.

I properly identified [REDACTED] after she showed me a digital photo of her Pennsylvania identification. I responded to the Main Stay Suites hotel to locate Mr. Brown. It was determined that Mr. Brown was not staying at this hotel. While on location, I found Mr. Brown's Pennsylvania identification on my MDT. I responded to MLPD HQ and generated a criminal complaint for conspiracy of shoplifting and obstruction by flight. A Defendant Identification Form and Victim Notification Form were completed.

Further investigation by Ptl Mowery revealed that Mr. Brown stayed in room [REDACTED] of the Comfort Inn. The front desk receptionist confirmed this after she showed police a photocopy of Mr. Brown's Pennsylvania identification that was on file. Nothing further to report.

On 06/2/2024 at 2224 hours, I was dispatched to 934 S RT 73 (Walmart) for a shoplifting.

Upon arrival, patrols made contact with [REDACTED] (Walmart loss prevention), who advised that he had observed two male suspects attempting to shoplift. Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he observed the suspects tampering with items in the video game and hardware department.

I viewed the live CCTV footage and observed the male suspects tampering with the video game display case.

I made contact with Juan Pachon-Cubides and Luis Solorzano-Sanchez, who advised that they were in the process of purchasing a blow-up pool. Let it be known that there was a language barrier, Ofc. Nieves had to assist in communications.

While speaking with suspects, patrols observed an item bulging from Mr. Solorzano-Sanchez's waistband. Mr. Solorzano-Sanchez quickly pulled a Socket set out of his waistband and discarded the item in a shopping cart.

The following items were concealed in Mr. Solorzano-Sanchez's pants:

Headlamp - \$1.88
Hyper Tough extension - \$10.44
Hyper Tough Socket - \$15.88
Totaling - \$28.20

While detaining Mr. Pachon-Cubides, I observed a three-pack of Little Trees Air Freshener protruding out of his right pant pocket. The total retail value of the item concealed on Mr. Pachon-Cubides was \$2.88.

On June 4th, 2024, at approximately 1758 hours, I was dispatched to 1000 Nixon Drive (Shop Rite) for a report of a robbery.

Upon arrival, I spoke to loss prevention officer [REDACTED] who reported that at approximately 1721 hours on 06/04/2024, an unknown white male described to be wearing a blue and white baseball jersey, sunglasses, black pants, and a black and red Phillies baseball hat and an unknown Hispanic male described to have a ponytail and wearing a grey sweatshirt with a black vest and blue jeans entered the store and began to fill a shopping cart with \$391.16 worth of merchandise. The suspects then passed all points of sale and attempted to exit the store through the front vestibule exit with the shopping cart full of merchandise. At this time, Mr. [REDACTED] stood in front of the exit to block the suspects from leaving.

Due to this, the Hispanic male suspect tried to push past Mr. [REDACTED]. Mr. [REDACTED] then grabbed the Hispanic male by his waist and tried to prevent the suspect from leaving. The unknown white male then attempted to pull Mr. [REDACTED] off of the other suspect and attempted to put Mr. [REDACTED] in a headlock. All three parties were then actively wrestling in the front vestibule. During this, Mr. [REDACTED] reported that the Hispanic male allegedly pulled a black foldable pocket knife out of his front right pant pocket. Mr. [REDACTED] then advised me that he saw the knife's blade; however, after further questioning him regarding the knife Mr. [REDACTED] reported that the Hispanic male was unable to open the knife to show the blade. After seeing the knife, Mr. [REDACTED] then disengaged and both suspects exited the store at approximately 1759 hours without the stolen merchandise.

After the suspects exited the store they were seen getting on bicycles, one neon bike and one black bike, and leaving the scene towards Route 73. While I was on scene additional officers checked the surrounding area; however, no individuals matching the description given by Mr. [REDACTED] were seen. While on scene Mr. [REDACTED] also provided me with a black backpack containing personal hygiene products, one (1) large black flashlight and (1) bronze flashlight, one (1) Allen key, one (1) flathead screwdriver, one (1) yellow cutting tool with "Caridad" written on the side in sharpie, and one (1) black Samsung phone with the box that was left behind by one of the suspects.

The backpack and the items inside have since been placed into evidence locker #3 and a property evidence form was completed.

Mr. [REDACTED] provided a receipt for the stolen items, which has since been submitted to the case file. The total amount shoplifted was \$391.16 and the items are described as various food and hygiene

Mr. [REDACTED] provided me with video surveillance of the incident which was placed onto a CD; however, after attempting to review the CD I found that the files had been damaged and could not be viewed at this time. A still photo was taken of the suspects and a TRAK message has since been created. All of the stolen merchandise was recovered and a written statement was also completed by Mr. [REDACTED] and the statement was placed in the case file.

On June 7th, 2024, I received CCTV footage from Shop Rite (1000 Nixon Drive) regarding case #2024-23278 concerning the reported robbery.

The footage was reviewed and based on the video I was able to identify the suspects in this case as Alfredo Acosta and Tyler A. Estelle. It should also be noted that on 06/05/2024 at approximately 0259 hours, after the reported robbery, MLPD was dispatched to 1200 South Rt73 (Holman Cadillac) regarding a trespassing complaint (case #2024-23328). The suspect in this case was then positively identified as Mr. Estelle who was seen on the ShopRite CCTV footage as one of the unidentified suspects. Mr. Estelle was observed to be wearing the same outfit in case #2024-23328 as he was when he was caught on security footage at ShopRite.

While speaking with Mr. Estelle regarding case #2024-23328 he also uttered that previously in the day he was with "Alfredo" who is now identified as Mr. Acosta based on the CCTV footage and Mr. Acosta's previous experience with MLPD.

After viewing the footage and being able to positively identify Mr. Acosta and Mr. Estelle as the suspects in this case, I contacted AP Mike Sullivan for charging recommendations. AP Sullivan was given the facts surrounding this case and advised that based on the probable cause both Mr. Acosta and Mr. Estelle should be charged with shoplifting and not robbery as of now.

The CD containing CCTV footage of the incident was placed into evidence locker #13 and a property evidence form was completed.

Charges are pending at this time. Nothing further to report.

On 06/12/24, at 1617 hours, I responded to 1300 Nixon Drive (Dick's Sporting Goods) for a shoplifting. Central advised that Dick's Sporting Goods staff, reported that a white or Hispanic male left the store carrying unpaid items out of the store.

Upon arrival, I was alerted by the Manager, [REDACTED] that she observed the suspect get into a black Kia car which she pointed out. I observed the vehicle parked in the Best Buy parking lot. My overhead lights were activated and my patrol vehicle was parked in front of the suspect vehicle. I observed the registration to be a NJ registration, X72-UBY. The entire vehicle had dark tinted windows and I was unable to see inside of the vehicle. I ordered the occupant/defendant, later identified as Steven H. Rice, to lower the windows. I then heard a voice stating that he could not lower the windows since he was in the backseat. I approached the rear passenger side door at which time I found the vehicle to be unlocked. I opened the door and observed Mr. Rice holding a razor blade on a glass board on top of the middle seat in the rear of the vehicle. I also observed a glass smoking pipe containing burnt residue. Merchandise containing hangers was also observed on the floorboards of the rear seat. I ordered Mr. Rice to show his hands and step out of the vehicle. Mr. Rice was compliant and listened to my instructions. Mr. Rice stated "I'm fucked huh?" Ptl. Abrusseze placed Mr. Rice under arrest with handcuffs adjusted and double locked. Search incident to arrest revealed negative findings of contraband on his person. Mr. Rice was placed in the rear seat of Patrol Vehicle #09 with seatbelt secured.
